Great things are happening. Students are finding new ways to get industry recognized credentials.

- Culinary students have the opportunity to earn their ServSafe Food Handlers Certification. This is over 390 students district wide.
- ISD 728 high school students in Auto, Woods, Construction, Welding and Manufacturing Classes have the opportunity to to complete the online **OSHA 10 Certification**.
- In partnerships with Guardian Angels and Anoka Ramsey Community College, 20 students a year can obtain their **Nursing Assistant Certification**

High school CTE programs that offer opportunities to earn industry recognized credentials are preparing students for the workplace. These credentials bring "real-world" standards and expectations into high school.

- For the student Industry recognized credentials are a mechanism that allows students to demonstrate mastery of knowledge and/or skills. They can increase job prospects and marketability to employers, as well as options for post-secondary education. An email from a student this year "I just finished my exam for the ServSafe Food Handler. I am honestly so proud of myself because I have been losing my memory for the past year and to be able to remember this information and get it right means a lot to my self-esteem and confidence."
- **For employers** Industry recognized credentials demonstrate evidence of workers' competencies, thus supporting hiring practices and filling specific employer-demanded knowledge, skills and abilities.
