8:00 a.m.	Off-site Competitions Depart from Mid-State Campus Dairy & Livestock students should take their folders with them and report to their respective busses. <u>Teams not registered and ready to depart on time will be disqualified and no refund will be issued.</u> Please note the facilities are unheated, competitors are encouraged to dress for the weather and outdoor conditions.
8:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m.	On-site Competitions Begin Name tag will indicate round number, start time, location, etc. students will be called and directed by a guide. <u>Refer to name tag and contest for specific schedule information</u>
11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.	Lunch Lunch will be available Grab and Go lunches provided by Festival Foods of Marshfield Menu: Kaiser roll sandwich with ham or turkey, cheddar cheese and lettuce. Apple or orange, chips, cookie, and bottled water. - Special purchase necessary
~12:30 p.m.	At approximately 12:30, Floriculture will host an info session. Students can hear from the judges, ask questions, and retrieve their arrangements at that time. Wait for the announcement.

2:30 p.m.	All Contests wrap-up/Depart

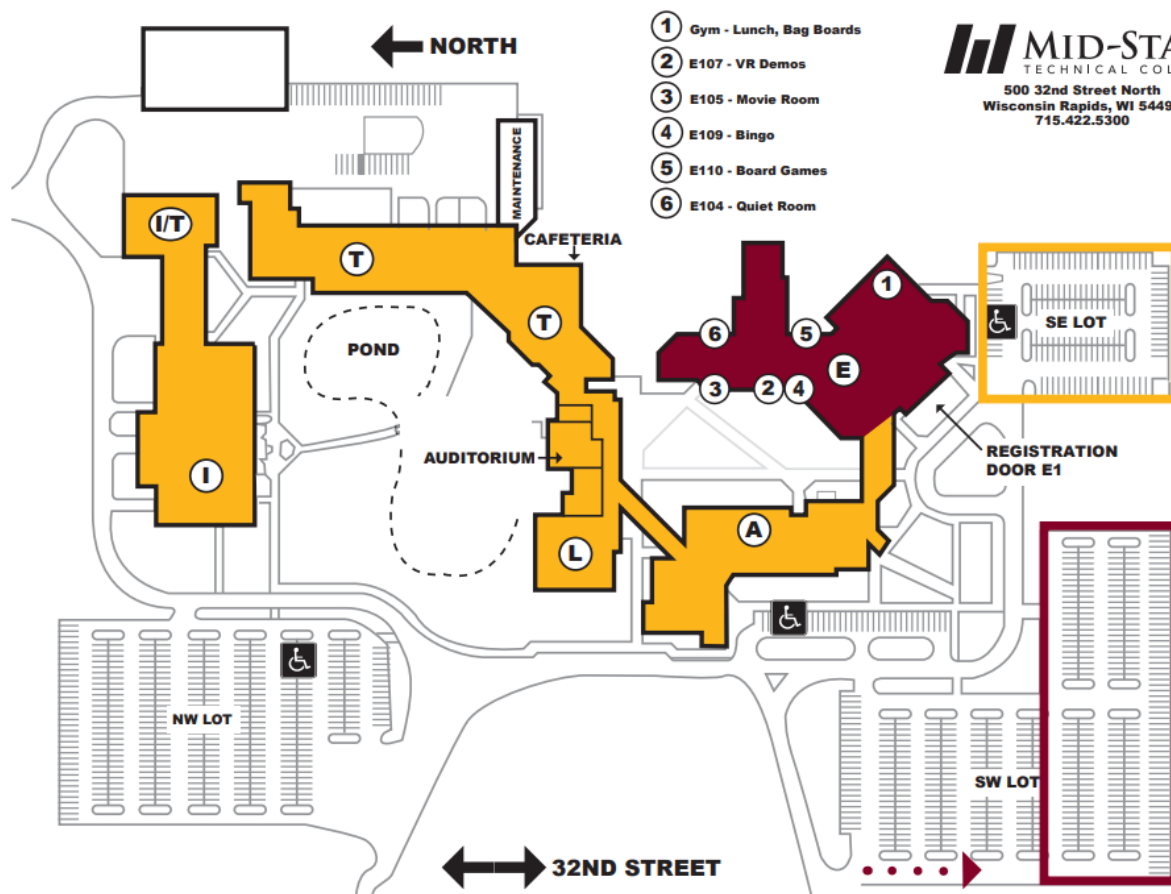
New for 2025 - All Mid-State Contests will transition to Scantron, please make sure to have clipboards and pencils!

Dress comfortably, official dress is not required for any contest.

Cell phones or other electronic devices are not allowed to be used in the competition areas. Competition areas on campus will be marked. All off-campus competition areas include all locations not on a school bus. If a student has a cell phone or other device in their hand during any event, they can be disqualified. Cell phones and other devices must be turned off and remain in a pocket during the entire event.

Students are expected to treat all volunteers, facilities, staff, and other competitors with respect. This includes not talking during events. Contest volunteers may disqualify individuals and teams who do not follow these expectations.
