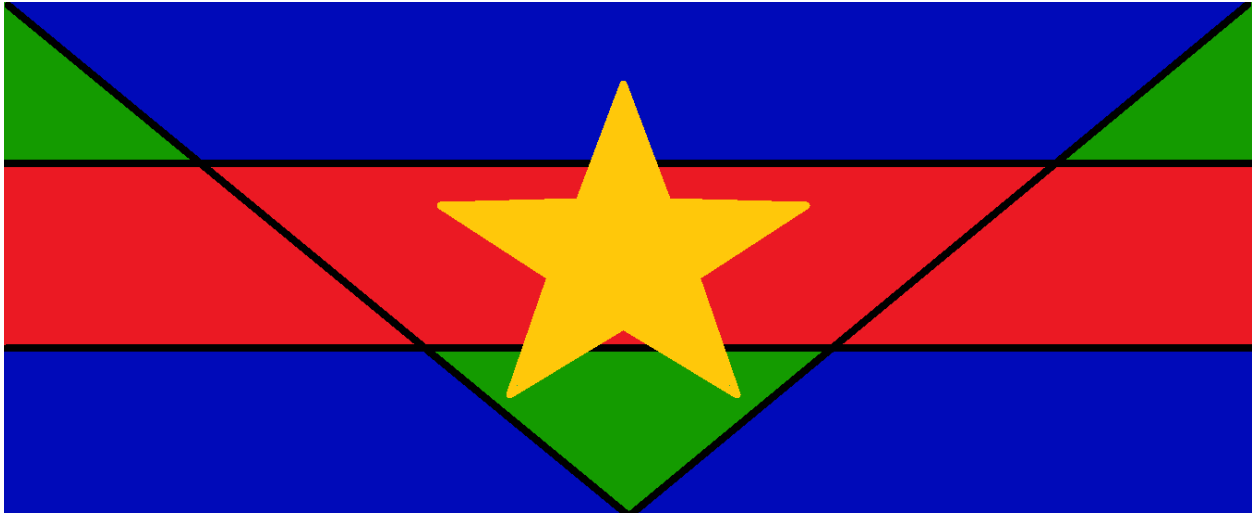


THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF GRASSFIN

Article I

- I. The name of this nation shall be The Republic of Grassfin, or, non-officially, Grassfin. These names shall be interchangeable.
- II. This shall be Grassfin's flag:



- III. Grassfin shall have the following national holidays (Gregorian calendar):
 - A. January 1- New Year's Day
 - B. February 14 - Valentine's day
 - C. April 22- Earth Day
 - D. August 28-Independence day
 - E. October 31-Halloween
 - F. 4th Thursday of November- Thanksgiving
 - G. November 25- Cheese day
 - H. December 24- Christmas eve
 - I. December 25- Christmas Day
 - J. December 31- New Year's Eve
- IV. More holidays may be added by the Head of the Department of Culture at any time.

Article II

- V. Grassfin is divided into states.
- VI. The current states are:
 - A. New Pineland
 - B. Phillington
 - C. Ge-terra
 - D. Constantinople
- VII. Each state elects 1 Senator to form the Senate.

VIII. To carry out its duties, the Senate conducts a vote, with 1 vote per Senator.

Article III

IX. The President is Head of state and Head of the Government of Grassfin.

X. The President outranks all Military officers.

XI. The President is democratically elected every election season.

XII. The rules for the election will be chosen by the Prime Minister but can be changed by the Senate.

XIII. The President can sign executive orders that act as laws, but cannot contradict the constitution or any laws passed in the normal way.

XIV. If the Senate believes that the President is not fit to serve, they can impeach him/her. To impeach the president, the Senate must hold a vote, needing 75% of the votes to pass.

XV. The President appoints a Vice President every election season.

XVI. If the President dies, is impeached, or resigns, the Vice President will become President.

Article IV

XVII. There shall be Departments to help run Grassfin.

1. The Department of Justice

The Department of Justice exists to uphold the laws of Grassfin. They will run a police department who arrest people who they believe has broken the law of Grassfin. They will then be tried by a judge and punished if found guilty.

2. The Department of the Treasury

The Department of the Treasury is in charge of all things pertaining to money.

3. The Department of Foreign Affairs

The Department of Foreign Affairs is in charge of all matters involving foreign states/nations.

4. The Department of Culture

The Department of Culture exists to promote and preserve the culture of Grassfin.

5. The Department of Media

The Department of Media regulates the press within Grassfin.

6. The Department of the Interior

The Department of the Interior manages all other affairs inside of Grassfin.

7. The Department of the Environment

The Department of the Environment regulates and defends the environment of Grassfin.

8. The Department of Industrial Regulation

The Department of Industrial Regulation makes regulations for industry and business.

9. The Department of Science

The Department of Science regulates and promotes science within Grassfin.

THE MILITARY:

XVIII. The Military's purpose is to protect and defend Grassfin through weaponry, tactics, and force.

Its branches are:

THE ARMY:

1. The Army conducts all land-based Military exercises.
2. Any citizen who has the approval of a Major or higher rank may sign up for the Army.
3. Newly enlisted Army soldiers will become the highest available rank.
4. The ranks are, in order from most power to least power:
 - A. High General
 - B. General
 - C. Sergeant
 - D. Major
 - E. Private
5. The Army is run by the High General, who is also the Department's Head.
6. The President may move troops in the Army at any time with an executive order, but the actions must be approved by the Senate within 2 weeks, or else they will be undone.
7. The Army is a department within Grassfin.

THE NAVY:

8. The Navy conducts all water-based Military exercises.
9. Any citizen who has the approval of a Lieutenant or higher rank may sign up for the Navy.
10. Newly enlisted Navy soldiers will become the highest available rank.
11. The ranks are, in order from most power to least power:
 - A. Grand Admiral
 - B. Admiral
 - C. Captain
 - D. Lieutenant
 - E. Seaman
12. The Navy is run by the Grand Admiral, who is also the Department's Head.
13. The President may move troops in the Navy at any time with an executive order, but the actions must be approved the Senate within 2 weeks, or else they will be undone.
14. The Navy is a department within Grassfin.

THE AIR FORCE:

15. The Air force conducts all air-based Military exercises.
16. Any citizen who has the approval of a Cadet or higher rank may sign up for the Air Force.
17. Newly enlisted Air Force soldiers will become the highest available rank.
18. The ranks are, in order from most power to least power:

- A. Head Marshal
- B. Marshal
- C. Commander
- D. Cadet
- E. Aircraftman

- 19. The Air Force is run by the Head Marshal, who is also the Department's Head.
- 20. The President may move troops in the Air Force at any time with an executive order, but the actions must be approved by Senate within 2 weeks, or else they will be undone.
- 21. The Air Force is a department within Grassfin.
- 22. Grassfin may declare war on any foreign power with the consent of The Senate, the President, and $\frac{2}{3}$ of the Military leaders.

XIX. All Department Heads are appointed by the President every election season.

THE PRIME MINISTER

- XX. The Prime Minister is elected by all Department Heads every election season.
- XXI. Their job is to help with the day-to-day running of Grassfin.
- XXII. They can issue orders to the departments in order to further Grassfin.

Article V

- XXIII. In order to create a law, it must be proposed to the Senate by a Senator, or the President, or a Department Head, or the Prime Minister.
- XXIV. It must then pass the senate with a simple majority, or 75% for a constitutional amendment.
- XXV. It must then get a signature from a Department Head whose Department deals with things related to the bill.
- XXVI. The the President must sign it into law.

Article VI

- XXVII. We, the People, of Grassfin, do hereby take this to be our constitution.
