

**Lillian (Scholl) Turner Peterson**

Lillian Rosella Scholl, daughter of (John) William and Rosa B. Brockman Scholl, was born July 27, 1909 in Lincoln Township, Cass County, IA. She was the youngest of 10 children.

Lillian attended rural schools and then graduated from Anita High School in 1928.

Merle Eldon Turner, son of Alvin Lester and Almyra "Myra" Mary (Biggs) Turner, was born July 13, 1906.

Lillian and Merle were married on June 6, 1928.

The couple had 4 children: Eldon Wayne in 1929, (Alvin) Gail in 1931, Joyce Eileen in 1933, and Lynn Drexel in 1936.

Merle passed away on October 14, 1946, at the age of 40.

Lillian continued to live on the farm 2 ½ miles southeast of Anita until she married (Alfred) Fay Peterson on November 1, 1956. They then lived on a farm east of Anita until moving to the town of Anita in 1966. Fay passed away June 14, 1981.

She liked to read and served as a substitute librarian at the Anita Public Library. She also made beautiful quilts and liked to crochet.

Lillian resided at Colonial Manor Nursing home for two years before her passing on November 10, 1998. She is buried in Evergreen Cemetery in Anita, IA.
