Camping Reservations & Policies

Reservations

- Reservations will not be accepted without a completed reservation form and full payment.
- Payment may be made by check (payable to Jeff Bursey Motorsports), Venmo, or PayPal.
- Campsite sizes vary in depth and width. If your camper or RV exceeds the dimensions listed in the pricing chart, please contact us to determine if accommodations can be made.
- A **two-night minimum stay** is required.
 - Check-in: **Friday, August 7th at 11:00 AM**
 - Check-out: **Sunday, August 9th by 10:00 AM**
- Campsites are **not guaranteed** until payment is received in full.
- **All payments are non-refundable.**

Camping Area Rules & Conduct

- **Quiet Hours:** 10:00 PM – 7:00 AM. Generators are not permitted during this time, except for approved medical necessities.
- **Waste Disposal:** Dumping gray or black water onto the ground is strictly prohibited and illegal in the State of New Hampshire.
- **Vehicles:** Only one vehicle per campsite is permitted. Please be respectful of neighboring spaces.

Pet Policy

- Dogs must be **leashed at all times**. Limit of 2 per site.
- Dogs are not permitted on the midway or in event/show areas. Dogs must remain on campsites or be leashed while in designated camping areas only.
- Dogs exhibiting **aggressive behavior or excessive barking** will be removed from the fairgrounds.
- The Campground and Event Staff reserve the right to remove any animal at their discretion.
- Pet owners assume **ALL** responsibility and liability for their animals.
- All pet waste must be immediately and properly disposed of.
- Dogs may not be left unattended outside at any time.

Prohibited Items

- The possession or use of any illegal, hazardous, or inappropriate items is strictly prohibited.
- This includes, but is not limited to, fireworks and all explosive materials.
- NO GOLF CARTS OR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED FOR PERSONAL USE UNLESS APPROVED BY THE FAIRGROUNDS OFFICE.

Safety & Responsibility

- Campers are responsible for securing their personal property. The Lancaster Fairgrounds and Great American Truck Jam staff are not liable for loss, theft, or damage.
- Campfires are permitted **in raised fire pits only** and must never be left unattended. Fires must be fully extinguished when leaving your site. Fires must be out by 10pm.
- Campers must occupy their **assigned campsite** and may not relocate without prior approval from the Event Staff or Campground Staff.

Alcohol Policy

- Alcohol consumption is permitted **only for individuals 21 years of age or older** and **only within your assigned campsite**.
- Alcohol may **not** be carried beyond campsites into the fairgrounds, including the midway, buildings, or entertainment areas.

Enforcement

- Any individual asked to leave due to rule violations or any reason will **not receive a refund**.
- These rules are established for the safety and enjoyment of all guests. Submission of the Campground Reservation Form and payment constitutes **acceptance of all policies** by the responsible party and all occupants of the campsite.

Pricing

- Full Hookup Site: \$65 per night
 - Back-in sites can accommodate most large RVs and big rigs.
