Student Handbook Policies

Our library media centers are available to all students on a daily basis during school hours. Digital resources including electronic books, audio books and informational databases and passwords can be accessed through the library website 24/7.

Our library emulates the [American Library Association](#) in providing resources from all points of view on current and historical issues. Parents are welcome to visit our library to choose materials with their children from our collection of resources.

1. The high school media center is open from 7:05am to 2:35pm, middle school media center from 7:45am to 3:15 pm, and elementary school from 8:30am to 4:00 pm.
2. Students can inform the library staff if materials are needed for an extended period of time. The following standard borrowing privileges include:
 - a. Three items may be checked out at one time.
 - b. Books may be borrowed for two weeks.
 - c. Equipment (cameras, headphones, microphones, etc) may be borrowed overnight.
3. Students may renew all materials up to three times if a hold has not been placed on the item by another student. Items may be renewed either in the library or through the online catalog.
4. Our school provides [electronic resources](#) and [informational databases](#) to provide students with online encyclopedias, periodicals, news, videos, and additional quality informational resources 24/7. [Passwords](#) to informational databases may be received through the NR bookmarks, library resources webpage after the student has logged in to their nrapps.org account.
5. Families have the ability to opt in for a digital public library card from [Cuyahoga County Public Library](#) upon registration. If you choose to not opt in for the initial North Royalton City Schools registration, a public library card can be received from any branch library within the Cuyahoga County

Public Library system. If you opted in, and would like to opt out, please visit the local branch library to delete your library card.
