Each year, the <u>Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation</u> awards 150 college scholarships worth \$20,000 to high school students across the United States through the Coca-Cola Scholars Program. Students need to be graduating high school during the 2025-2026 school year, have at least a 3.0 GPA, and to complete an <u>online application</u> that requires no essays, no recommendations, and no transcript by September 30, 2025, at 5 p.m. Eastern.

FRESHMAN SAFE DRIVING EXPERIENCE

This year's event will take place at the Shelby County Farm Bureau office and 4-H Fairgrounds on Tuesday, September 2nd, from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

The day will be set up similarly to how it has operated in the past. All high schools in Shelby County are invited, and all students attending will be split into smaller groups to visit four stations where young leaders, farmers, and implement operators will address important information for drivers to be aware of. Some key topics will include semi-safety when approaching large equipment on the road, blind spots with large equipment, SMV vehicles, closing time, perception of distances, meeting large equipment on major roads vs. country roads, distracted driving. The organizers are hoping to add a new session this year that will include powerline safety if involved in an accident.

■ WHAT IS GO GUARDIAN?

Sanctions for alcohol and other drug violations, including tobacco, nicotine in any form, mood-altering or performance enhancing drugs, products composed purely of caffeine in a loose powdered form, paraphernalia or any other illegal substance, will be based on the following:

- 1st Offense: Loss of 20% of extracurricular season
- 2nd Offense: Loss of 50% of extracurricular season
- 3rd Offense: Suspended from participation for 1 calendar year

The handbook also specifies that a student attending a party, a gathering, or riding in a vehicle where alcoholic beverages and/or controlled substances are being consumed is considered guilty by association.
