

Obtaining Your Dual Immersion and World Language Endorsements

Since each situation is different and there are multiple pathways to obtaining these endorsements, it is best to check with Human Resources for guidance on your best route. The ones listed below are those typically required for most teachers who already have a professional educator license. Check with [Travis Rawlings](#) in Granite District HR to see what you need to do. If you are earning your license through the Granite APPEL program, please refer to your professional learning plan.

Prior to Signing Contract if possible	Take Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) or (OPIc) through LTI if you have not yet done so. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) • ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview-computer (OPIc) • Requirement: Advanced Mid Cost: \$145 for OPI; \$73 for OPIc	
Before 1st year teaching if possible	Take Language Praxis Test if you have not yet done so. Information: ETS Praxis Link: www.ets.org/praxis . Spanish: World Language 5195, French World Language 5174, Chinese (Mandarin) World Language 5665 Note: Only offered at specific times throughout the year. Please plan ahead. Passing Score: Spanish- 168, French- 160, Chinese- 145 Cost: \$170	
Summer before 1st year teaching	Attend AUDII. Usually, it is the 1 st week of August and is required for your Dual Immersion Endorsement. You will attend the track for 1 st year teachers. Cost: \$0	
September of 1st year (Before October 1st)	Apply for the Associate level of the Dual Language Immersion Endorsement . You'll find the requirements for the Associate level on the Specs document . This gives you 3 years to complete the requirements for the professional endorsement and allows you "teach Dual Language Immersion classes while working on the DLI Endorsement" DLI: https://www.schools.utah.gov/curr/dualimmersion <i>If you fail to submit these documents, you may be placed on an LEA Specific Endorsement.</i> Cost: \$0	
September of 1st year (Before October 1st)	Apply for the Associate World Languages Endorsement . You'll find the requirements for the Associate level on the Specs document . This gives you 3 years to complete the requirements for the professional endorsement and allows you "teach Dual Language Immersion classes while working on the World Languages Endorsement" WL: https://www.schools.utah.gov/curr/worldlanguages <i>If you fail to submit these documents, you may be placed on an LEA Specific Endorsement.</i> Cost: \$0	
Spring or Summer	Take Foundations in Dual Language Immersion Course if you have not already done so. Granite typically offers the course Summer Semester around the 2 nd week of June. Contact Mike Krasinski for more information. Cost for Granite employees: \$80. For outside applicants: \$480.	
Summer before 2nd year	Attend the 2nd year of AUDII. Usually, it is the 1 st or 2 nd week of August and is required for your Dual Immersion Endorsement. You will attend the track for 2 nd year teachers. Cost: \$0	
Winter - 2nd year Submit application	All Educator Endorsement Applications must be submitted digitally to https://usblicensing.smapply.us Check "This is an application for a Professional Dual Language Immersion endorsement." Check "This is an application for a World Language Endorsement". List language. Follow instructions to complete and submit both applications. Cost: \$0
