

Medication & Health Information

The attached “Emergency Medical Authorization” and “Authorization to Administer Medication” forms are extremely important. Thank you for carefully reading and following the directions to help us support your son or daughter while at Estes Park.

*Please fill in all emergency contact information legibly.

***Please attach FRONT and BACK copies of your insurance card OR Medicaid card.**

***If you do not have a health insurance provider, please write “N/A” in the line for Provider.**

*Be certain to read and fill-in both sides of the BLUE form.

*In the event that you do not have information to share on the back side of the blue form, please indicate you have read the questions by putting a check or “N/A” next to numbers 1-6.

If you have indicated your son or daughter will be taking medications on the trip (#3), please use the attached WHITE “Parent/Guardian Authorization to Administer Medication at School” – “Health Care Provider Authorization to Administer Medication at School” form.

*This form must be filled out by you **AND** your child’s health care provider.

*One form for each medication must be filled out for prescription **AND** any over the counter medications. Please make a copy of the form for each medication.

When preparing medications for your son or daughter please:

*Medication and forms **MUST** be received by our Clinic by the Monday prior to your student’s trip. ***Medication WILL NOT be accepted after Monday OR the day of departure.***

*Send medication in a plastic bag clearly marked with your son or daughter’s name on the outside. Medications should be in their original packaging with dosage information.

*Please understand that we cannot use another student’s medication for your son or daughter. We do not carry extra epi-pens or other prescription medications with us.

Finally, if your student has a recent acute injury that limits mobility, you will need to contact our clinic para professional to schedule a meeting with our district nurse for clearance to participate safely.
