

# Tverečius RCC Birth Register Entry Data Table for 1906-1909

(selected entries from 1906-1909 Tverečius RCC birth register (LVIA record F.1332 Ap.1 B.30))

**General.** This Register Entry Data Table (REDT) contains translations / transcriptions of the primary names, dates, and places recorded in *selected* entries from the online 1906-1909 birth register of Tverečius Roman Catholic church (RCC). Tverečius is a town in Lithuania; it is in the Ignalina municipality in Utena county. The translations are necessary because the entries in this Tverečius RCC register were about ethnic Lithuanians but the entries were not written in the Lithuanian language.

Note: This Table covers the register period from 4 Jun 1906 through 19 Apr 1909. This Table is a "short form" that has rows only for those register entries where at least the surname of a parent or godparent of a baptized child has been transcribed and/or translated from the register; there are no blank rows for the other entries.

**Selection of Entries for Inclusion in Table.** This Register Entry Data Table contains only a *selected* subset of the entries in the online 1906-1909 Tverečius RCC birth register. My primary objective is to eventually include every entry where a parent of the baptized child has one of my ancestral surnames. My ancestral surnames within Tverečius RC parish are: Čepulis, Klonis, Kondratavičius, Kudaba, Lukšas, Lukšėnas, Maciukas, Pauliukėnas, Stasiūnas, Telyčėnas, Vitėnas. Many additional entries are also included for various reasons.

**Languages.** The entries in the 1906-1909 register are *handwritten* in the Russian language. In the Table below: the names of Lithuanian people and places are in modern Lithuanian; any text *transcribed* from the register entries is enclosed in parentheses; and all other information is in English.

**"Reverse Translation".** In general, the names of ethnic Lithuanian people and places were often "Polonized" (converted into Polish-language versions of the names) by the priests who entered the names in the RCC registers, and the names were *trans-literated* into Russian for entry in the Russian-language register. When translating register entries, Lithuanian genealogists attempt to reverse the original conversion process; they attempt to convert the Polonized names back into corresponding Lithuanian-language names, and they use the surname suffixes of modern Lithuanian. The Lithuanian names that appear below in the Register Entry Data Table have been converted / translated from the Polonized names back into Lithuanian names. This process is relatively straightforward for *place* names and *given* names, but the translation of *surnames* can be highly subjective, and alternative similar surnames are often possible.

**Transcribed Text.** In the Register Entry Data Table, the names and selected words that are *enclosed in parentheses ( )* are my transcriptions of the handwritten names and words as they appear in the register entries [with some exceptions as explained in the Generic Endnotes to the Tables]. [The general exception: The surnames of the fathers of the baptized children are typically in the Genitive-case plural-form in the actual register, but the *suffixes* of the transcribed surnames in the Table below have been adjusted to show instead the Nominative-case singular-form.]
