**Information and Ideation: CTE Pathways**

Steve Douglass discussed the career technical education pathways that the school has been offering and what the plan is for the future to provide more opportunities for students. District will need to lean on the community for opportunities to provide endorsements to students at places like Abbvie, Grainger, and other small businesses. There are seventeen clusters that will have to be offered by the District; currently there are two being offered. Within those clusters there are a number of pathways that can be followed. There will need to be a transition from AP classes to dual credit classes. Open doors job shadowing will be on February 21, 2024.
