Review school-specific schedules and guidance from teachers with your student	<p>--Memorize your student's login to their Chromebook and monitor their Chromebook use</p> <p>--Clearly communicate and reiterate the academic expectations of your student. You should state these learning expectations often:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Your student must be present at the beginning of each class period at the scheduled time to participate in each live Zoom class and receive daily instructions for learning b) Your student must submit meaningfully completed academic schoolwork daily, before 6:59am of the following day the schoolwork was assigned c) Your student is expected to utilize their academic calendar to practice organization skills and to communicate with you their upcoming academic tasks <p>--Read Principal Hargrave's weekly newsletter (sent on Sundays) to learn about what is expected in each of your student's classes</p>
Review district-wide guidance on plans for grading	<p>--Students will be assessed on our identified Essential Learning Standards separately. Each standard will be assessed and communicated as students complete a collection of evidence of proficiency</p> <p>--Expect an update in PowerSchool at least once every eight days for each class period</p>
Support your child(ren) with checking and submitting assignments	<p>--Ask your student - at least once every other day - to show you the specific classes posted in Canvas</p> <p>--Set a meeting between you and your student at least two times each week to review proficiency (grading) updates in PowerSchool</p> <p>--Your student will be measured at least once every eight days in each of their classes</p>
Contact your child's/children's school(s) if you have questions	<p>--Call (503) 630-8516 and leave a message for our school</p> <p>--Email emsinfo@estacada.k12.or.us with any questions</p>
Families should proactively notify their teacher or a school administrator with any concerns about progress or additional support needed	<p>--We will celebrate and reward families who are regular attenders and regulate engagers to their students' learning</p> <p>--We will support families with barriers to attending online classes</p> <p>--When your student is marked absent it will be because they did not participate in class nor did they meaningfully complete an academic task by 6:59am on the next school day. When your student misses more than half of the week's classes, we will contact you.</p> <p>--Teachers will be measuring student engagement weekly. If your student is "not attending" or "participating but not completing" in more than half of their classes throughout the week, then we will be in contact with you.</p>
Families should ensure that students are adhering to their school's contract for appropriate behavior on web enabled devices	<p>--Discuss with your student EMS's behavior matrix for distance learning</p>
