Irvine Unified School District will be administering a FREE PreACT to all students on Monday,
Oct 9, 2023 .

Students need to arrive at the Creekside Education Center, 3387 Barranca Parkway Irvine, CA 92606 for testing beginning promptly at 8:30 AM. Please bring with you a school ID or California ID card and approved calculator, although all questions can be answered without one. Click [HERE](#) for the list of approved calculators. Testing will conclude at approximately 12:30PM.

We will also be delivering our Equal Opportunity Schools Annual Survey at this time.

This multiple choice assessment provides 10th graders with short practice for the ACT test, as well as a full view of students' college and career readiness by identifying areas of strength and improvement for student success.

With PreACT, you can get useful information to help your child choose the right high school courses, think about ways to work on areas for improvement, and even begin discussions about their college and career interests. This year, we've chosen to administer the PreACT as one of the first actionable steps your sophomores can take to become ready for college and plan for the future.

Key Benefits of taking the PreACT include:

- PreACT score and predicted ACT score ranges align to the ACT 1-36 scale
- Students may opt to share their information with colleges and scholarship agencies
- ACT Interest Inventory results provide students with a personalized view of interests with college and career alignment.
- Access to ACT Academy, which provides free, personalized practice for the ACT

As a part of this assessment, students will be asked to complete an optional pretest survey prior to the actual test administration. Please note that these surveys may provide opportunities for families to learn about college choices. Also, by completing the survey you are opting in to possibly having your responses shared with third parties.
