

Staff Safety

The Board recognizes that safety and health standards should be incorporated into all aspects of the operation of ESD 123. Rules for the safety and prevention of accidents shall be posted in compliance with OSHA and WISHA requirements. All hazardous chemicals will be identified and properly labeled.

Staff members will be trained in the use of these chemicals specific to their respective jobs. Proper records will be maintained to verify that all of the preventive and safety measures are in place. Injuries and accidents shall be reported to ESD 123 safety committee within a timeframe commensurate with its severity.

ESD 123 shall have at least one (1) staff member at each program and work site in ESD 123 who holds a valid certificate of first aid training from the Department of Labor and Industries, U.S. Bureau of Mines, or the American Red Cross, or equivalent training provided by ESD 123. Each program and worksite shall have first aid supplies readily accessible and if the worksite has more than fifty (50) employees, a first-aid station shall be established.

The Superintendent shall develop necessary safety and health standards to comply with Department of Labor requirements.
