II. Approval of Previous Minutes

November updates recap:

- A. Due to medical issues, Nutz will be inactive in the tribe until April or May. We will need everyone else to take on a bit more in the meantime while we get projects for 2023 started. We can't wait until May to start preparing.
- B. Be mindful of updates. We've got some talks in the works regarding tribe placement and camp layout, so check Discord regularly. Further, the November update does include important information relating to tribe dues and upcoming changes to the camp layout, so be sure to review that when you can.
- C. Beginning in 2023, we will require a minimum of eight attendees aligned with the Tribe. This can be any combination of Recruits and Members. While we may be technically able to build the set and run the camp with less than eight people, it places a huge burden on those who do attend, both in terms of labor and finances. It's not sustainable and we run the risk of burnout. Therefore, in the future, if we have less than eight attendees, the Public Eye will not attend WW as a tribe for that year.
- D. As a reminder, all attendees are responsible for transporting their own equipment to the event site. We had some issues this year with people not making advance plans for equipment transportation, and it placed an unnecessary burden on our tribemates. Moving forward, we may not have any extra space in the rental truck so please plan accordingly.
- E. Beginning this year, we'll be adding an additional function to the trash director role. All tribe Members and Recruits will be responsible for separating trash and recycling, and the trash director will be responsible for bringing recycling across the event site to another camp. This camp brings their collections to a recycling center and donates the proceeds.
- F. The changes to the Snitch Bitch game that we made for 2022 will be made permanent moving forward. Snitches will now need to lead us to the

target.

G. Loading and unloading equipment before and after the event are necessary functions of tribe attendance. Tribe members are responsible for helping with organizing the storage unit, loading the set onto the truck, and organizing and packing the bar and any additional supplies. Afterwards, we'll also need a dedicated team to unload and repack the set at the storage unit, clean and return the truck, and clean any dishes and bar equipment prior to storing. Please include these needs in your plans in this and upcoming years. Further, these are great opportunities to help out the tribe if you're unable to attend the actual event but still want to participate or assist.

We're in need of recruits for the coming year. Ideally, every tribe member should aim to bring in at least 1 new recruit this year. Further, we may want to consider refocusing our efforts towards people who already attend Wasteland Weekend but are not currently aligned with a tribe. Telling someone to attend the event for the first time, work while they're there, and contribute to tribe dues is a hard sell. It may be easier to recruit someone who already knows and loves the event by framing it as the next step in contributing towards making Wasteland what it is.
