FAQs about Color's Vaccine Program

Appointment Management:

Multi-site view for appointments/vaccines:

- Q: I want to see all sites within a population that have specific vaccines and appointment availability. Then, I want to be able to schedule an appointment at one of the locations. How can I do that?
 - 1. Go to the site's primary calendar:
 - (Appointment Management → Actions→Manage Calendars→ Copy primary calendar link and put into a new tab
 - Once in the new tab, delete all text following the Question Mark (?) including the question mark. This will revert the view to the population level, not the site level.

 - This appointment management view will then show all available sites for the vaccines selected. The patient could then book an appointment at the site that has the vaccine available.
 - There is not an option to see all available appointments

Calendar:

- Can you delete calendars?
 - Not if there is a vaccine associated with them/administered under them (record keeping)
 - If made in error, email Support and we can look into it

Dashboard questions:

- How to see how many appointments / patients came through a specific site during a specific date range:
 - Dashboard → Appointments Overview → Filter to site, time frame, etc→ review Complete Appointments
- How real time are the dashboards updated?

Language:

- How can we register in different languages, and where is the site translated?

Insurance:

- How can you make the insurance search easier?

<p>It's been difficult for us to consolidate our clinics into one clinic if we have differing amounts of Regular and High Dose Flu vaccine being offered. There is a feature to put them both under the same clinic but it's very hard to track (to assure that you are only booking the amount of appointments you have for each dose).</p> <p>Also, there seems to be an issue with individuals registering for an appointment with certain birthdates. <p>It would be great if, while creating appointments, we could input how many appointments we'd like to offer a certain vaccine. For example, if I had 20 COVID-19 vax left and 15 flu vax, it would be great if I could create 20 appointments, and once 15 people are registered for the flu vax, only COVID-19 will be offered, if that makes sense.</p>	<p>jbarmashi@bedfordma.gov</p>		
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<p>I'd like to be able to cap registrations by vaccine type for clinics or days. I'd also like to be able to restrict registrations by age per vaccine type. I'd like to be able to easily move on patient registration to another site. <p>Limitations with the system have made this vaccine season more challenging. We would love to be able to add age restrictions by vaccine type in a clinic. For example: We wanted to host a public clinic that offers Flu vaccine to all ages, & COVID vaccine to be limited to the 65+ population. <p>When cancelling an appointment--I do not like the response that is programmed in---we should be able to put our own message in. 9 times out of 10 the programmed response does not reflect what has occurred.</p> <p>Should be able to repeat basic info when scheduling more than one person from the same household</p>			
<p>The biggest change I would like to see is the ability to reschedule cancelled appointments or follow up appointments at different sites. We provide mobile vaccine clinics and often people need to cancel on a certain date at "Site A" and need to reschedule for a different date at "Site B". The ability for us to do that in the field or on the phone would save us SO MUCH TIME!</p> <p>The insurance platform is still really hard for people to use. The VPC ID process is still clunky.</p>			
<p>When entering color info for patients retroactively, it would be helpful to be able to add the vaccination date rather than it automatically being set to the day the information is entered and if that wasn't possible it would be helpful to be able to change several vaccination dates at the same time rather than having to do it one vaccine at a time.</p>			

<p>It would be great to remove old inventory but the most important thing that color needs is for a site to be notified when a patient schedules an appointment. When we don't have specific dates for clinics, patients might schedule at any random time and there have been times that a patient showed up and we didn't know they were coming so we didn't have a provider or vaccines ready. <p>-I find it difficult to add patient appts. If I speak to someone and schedule them for a 2pm appt I have to first create the appt slot, then go back and schedule it. My work around was to have a private scheduling link that always has appts open. However, once the patient is scheduled they are given that link to reschedule. <p>-If you add/modify which vaccines a patient gets after they schedule, you have to fill out the full pre-vaccination checklist again and can't see their prior answers. <p>Once up and running Color works very well for entering info at the flu clinics I support, but logging in is a nightmare!! Requiring extra verification at every log-in is difficult because the public buildings we work in often block some of the second-tier verification sites.
