

This document provides information about all of the Solar for All (SFA) awardees that plan to originate loans or provide other support for solar power generation in the state of Indiana. In particular, this document provides the name of each awardee, the amount that they were awarded, and a brief description of their plans for that award. The proposals submitted by SFA applicants were not released by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), so the summaries listed here were published by the EPA, itself.

Indiana:

Lead applicant name: Indiana Community Action Association, Inc. (IN-CAA)

Award amount: \$117,470,000

Project description: SFA Indiana (SFAI) is a coalition of municipal governments and community entities in Fort Wayne, Gary, Indianapolis, and Columbus, combined with six statewide organizations. The coalition will collectively solarize low-income homes while transforming the market in Indiana by creating new financial products and incentives that jumpstart solar for low-income residents, new affordable housing developments, and more. In dialogue with utility companies, and in tandem with school-to-work industry development efforts, the coalition is committed to leading toward solar in Indiana from the grassroots upward.
