

Listening 7: Songs about a homeland

Warm-up w/ hands

Clap: Watermelon, Ice cream; ask volunteer to pick what do do standing in place (spin/ hop...)

1. Play 1st song. Have children draw, but don't introduce song.
2. Share info-
 - a. *Welcome Poor Paddy Home* (written by Charles Kickham, in 19th century)
 - b. Voice, fiddle, bodran, bones, mandola, bouzouki, accordion, flute, whistles
 - c. Dervish, with Cathy Jordan
 - d. 2012
 - e. Ireland
3. Listen again and draw.

*Break to clap and move x2.

4. Play 2nd song. Have children draw, but don't introduce song.
5. Share info-
 - a. *بلادي يا زين البلدان* (*Bladi, My Country*)
 - b. Voice and ensemble
 - c. *نعمان لحلو* / Nouamane Lahlou
 - d. contemporary
 - e. Morocco
6. Listen again and draw.
