**INTRODUCTION** (*no sub-chapters or numbering*).

It contains a description that answers why the research or study is carried out and its objectives. Written in 11pt normal style with 1.15 spacing

**RESEARCH METHOD** (*no sub-chapters or numbering*).

It should clearly describe the materials used in the research and their descriptions, research procedure, observed/ measured variables, research design, experimental design and data analysis techniques, written with 11pt normal font style, 1.15 spacing.

**RESULTS**

Make sure research result has a description, written with 11pt normal font style 1.15 spacing.

### **CONCLUSION** (*no sub-chapters or numbering*)

Presenting conclusions that is drawn from the results and discussion, consistent with the research objectives, written in 11pt normal font with 1.15 spacing

If any, acknowledgments are expressed after the conclusion. Acceptable thanks are those related to academic activities, for example thanks to research funders, experts who play a role in discussions, data collection or data analysis that are directly related to the research/writing presented. (Times New Roman, 11pt Spacing 1.15).
