Building your Vision page.

People will partner with you far more for the vision in your life than the needs in your life.

They already know your needs; they do not yet know your vision.

Pictures - Stories

Even if friends and family are not yet familiar with our YWAM way of living by faith and not receiving a wage, don't focus on this!

We want them to be captivated by what they see God is calling us to, far more than our need for staff fees, outreach fees, or the next conference.

When people see what we are doing because of our vision and learn we are unpaid, the Holy Spirit will move their hearts and minds far more than our requests.

If they only know we are unpaid, they may only think we are a little weird.

- **Don't lead with your need.**
- **Lead with your Vision.**

Each one of these questions could be a webpage in itself.

- Ask God for answers to these questions.
- Make them a focus of a quiet time.
- Find scriptures that relate to them.
- Meditate on these questions and keep a journal for what God says.
- Gather pictures of things you have done that align with your vision.
