Kindergarten

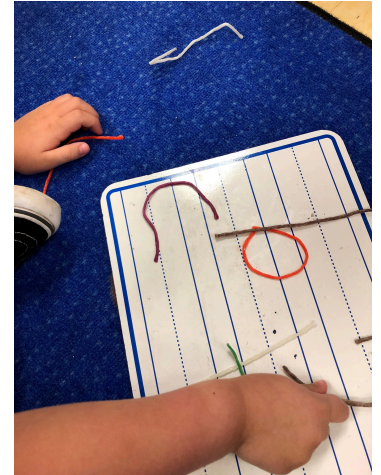
Phonics - Students recognized and learned the sounds of the letters A through N.

Math - Students identified the numbers 1 - 6. They practiced counting numbers while making crafts.



Handwriting - Students have been busy practicing writing their letters, numbers and most importantly, their name!

Teachers used multi sensory learning centers to reinforce both math and phonics using playdough, dry erase boards, magnetic letters, Wiki Sticks and sand.



Students listened to stories and sang songs about letters and numbers.

Grade 1

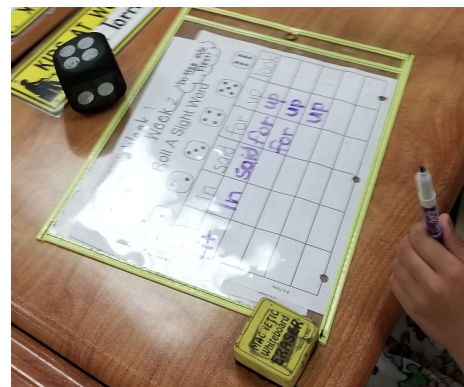
Phonics - Students practiced recognizing the difference between long and short vowel sounds. They practiced their decoding skills to read one syllable words.

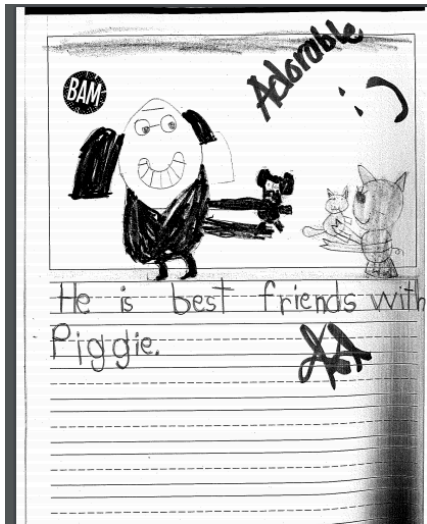


Math - Students practiced counting numbers 1-20. They learned the concept of addition and subtraction and had fun acting out number problems.
