



CREMATED REMAINS INTERMENT CEMETERY POLICY

It is to be understood that by purchasing this burial space for cremated remains, I agree to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. This is not a Perpetual Care Cemetery; however Trinity Church has maintained this cemetery over 100+ years and is prepared to continue, provided funds are available.
2. The interment of the cremated remains shall be the responsibility of the family or designated party.
3. Each burial space 22.5" x 22.5" after shall be covered with plastic and back filled with a grey gravel or slag material. No grass will be planted in the 22.5" x 22.5" area. No other plantings or digging into the rock covering is allowed. Any flowers should be placed in their own container and placed near the burial. This is to keep everything symmetrical and pleasing to the eye.
4. Should the relatives responsible wish to mark the burial space, then the following stipulations shall be followed:
 1. The burial space will be marked with a black polished granite marker showing only the name – birth date & death date --- nothing else.
 2. The marker shall have the following specifications ---
 1. Black Granite
 2. Polished face
 3. Rough cut on sides and back
 4. Laser Lettered
 5. Grade -
 6. Supplier-
 1. The reason for the specifications is to guarantee that all the markers will be the same.
 2. It shall have the following dimensions --- 8" square x 2" thick
 1. The cost of the marker, engraving and installation shall be the responsibility of the family.
 2. The marker shall be centered in the opening.

3. When this cremated burial area was constructed in 2017 the marker with engraving cost approximately ~ \$450.00 from Henneke FH. Trinity Church does not guarantee what the cost will be in future.
