- Review your transcript. Understand the difference between your weighted and unweighted GPA.
- Review your four year high school academic plan on [SchoolLinks](#)
- Continue career exploration. Complete your Xello inventories to find and explore career matches that are a good fit for you. Save and research careers and education required.
- Focus on your goals for academic and personal success.
- Monitor your grades regularly using your powerschool portal. Use study groups and tutors as needed.
- Seek teachers out individually and utilize after school tutoring for support.
- Explore extracurricular interests and activities, such as clubs and community service.
- Get involved. Keep a log of all extracurricular activities.
- Apply for private scholarships. Check the [Mead High School Scholarship Database](#) to see what scholarships you may be able to apply for in the future.
- Register for appropriate AP tests.
