Tips, Tricks and Strategies for use

Biteslide is a great way to run creative projects to your students. Here's one way to approach using it with your students.

1. Set a project for your students - it could be a story, biography, portfolio, etc. An example slidebook will help students.
2. **Research** - Have your students use text, Google Images, Youtube, the web, and Uploads to gather project assets.
3. **Create** - Have students design their slidebook narrative and use Biteslide Extras to add visual appeal.
4. **Present** - Once the project is finished, use presentation mode to present the slidebook to the class.

as to consider

- Students can collaborate on slidebooks in small teams.
- Use the comments on a slidebook to give feedback during slidebook creation
- Allow other students to critique each others slidebooks in the comments
- Use project settings to disable features (e.g. Youtube, Google Images, commenting) for younger students.
- Enable slidebook embedding to share finished slidebooks on the school blog or wiki.
