Requirements:

- Your episode must be 4-5 minutes (no longer than 5 minutes for the [NYTimes Podcast Contest](#))
- Reference at least 2 recent, relevant studies wherein you demonstrate your understanding of the purpose, research methods, results and real world applications
- Cite at least 3 sources (including the 2 studies mentioned above)
- Personal elements (at least 2) that makes the content relatable to the audience - ex. "pop vox" style interviews, interview with an expert or someone affected by the issue, personal anecdote, conversation between hosts... be creative!
- Appropriate music and sound effects.
- You must submit it to the contest. When you share your link with me, please include a screenshot of the submission confirmation email.

You will be scored on your accuracy, connections between research and content we are studying, creativity, and successful demonstration of appropriate use of technology.
