

UChicago Educators: Statement of Support for the Gaza Encampment

As educators whose labor includes teaching and TAing courses at the University of Chicago, we stand in solidarity with the people of Gaza and in support of students participating in the UChicago United for Palestine (UCUP) encampment.

At the time of writing, Gaza has suffered more than [200 days of unrelenting genocide](#) at the hands of the Israeli state and its US backers. The consequences of this genocidal assault have been nothing short of horrific. More than 34,000 Palestinians have been slaughtered, including at least 14,000 children, along with 77,000 wounded and 7,000 buried under the rubble. At least 1.1 million Palestinians now suffer catastrophic food insecurity as a result of Israel's [systematic denial](#) of food and water, a policy that has already led to [at least 27 known deaths](#) by starvation and dehydration. Fully 85% of Gaza's residents have been forcibly displaced, with 62% of the territory's homes destroyed or severely damaged.

As if all this weren't appalling enough, Israel has [methodically laid waste](#) to the very foundations of human life in Gaza. Already by mid-December, Israel had [destroyed or damaged](#) 77% of Gaza's healthcare facilities, 211 of its mosques and churches, 195 of its heritage sites, half of its roads, and more than 60% of its educational facilities. By late March, it had [destroyed](#) over 40% of Gaza's farmable land and [severely damaged](#) 24 of its hospitals as well. This wholesale destruction of Gazan society has additionally involved a [systematic assault](#) on Palestinian higher education. Since the genocide's onset, Israel has partly or fully destroyed [every university](#) in Gaza and killed at least 231 academics, a process that Scholars Against the War on Palestine have termed "[scholasticide](#)."

The role that the US government and US academic institutions have played in enabling Israel's atrocities is difficult to overstate. The Biden administration has authorized [more than 100 distinct arms transfers](#) in the course of this genocide, in addition to [vetoing](#) multiple ceasefire resolutions at the UN Security Council and recently [sending](#) Israel an additional \$17 billion in military aid. Within this same timeframe, US academic institutions have doubled down on their complicity with Israel in a variety of ways, including by refusing to divest from Israel's arms suppliers, maintaining partnerships with [state- and military-linked Israeli universities](#), and cracking down viciously on students and faculty who protest these collaborationist policies.

The University of Chicago has been representative in this regard. Despite months of continuous protest from students and faculty, it has steadfastly refused to confront [its extensive complicity](#) in Israeli genocide, apartheid, and [scholasticide](#). It has refused to cut ties with the [Israel Institute](#), a propaganda organization designed to push a pro-Israel agenda in US academic spaces. It has refused to terminate partnerships with Israeli academic institutions, despite the [well-documented role](#) these institutions play in [developing](#) Israeli military technology, stealing Palestinian land,

and [upholding](#) Israel's occupation regime. It has refused to divest from [General Dynamics and other major weapons manufacturers](#), knowing full well that these companies' weapons are being used to annihilate the very foundations of human life in Gaza. It has refused to hold a public meeting with pro-Palestinian students, preferring to [mass arrest them](#) and [meet with Israeli state officials](#) instead. And it has refused to acknowledge that a genocide and scholasticide is taking place at all, notwithstanding the clear and voluminous evidence has been [presented](#) at the International Court of Justice and broadcasted before our eyes for months.

Enough is enough. We condemn our University's complicity in Israel's crimes and stand in unequivocal support of protests demanding an end to it. We call on University administrators to meet [UCUP's three demands](#): public disclosure of University finances, full divestment from the Gaza genocide, and reparation for the harms to which the University has contributed in Palestine, the South Side, and beyond. We further pledge, as University of Chicago educators, not to teach or TA for any courses that feed into our institution's complicity with Israel, including those affiliated with the Israel Institute or hosted by apartheid Israeli universities. For all its rhetoric of political neutrality, this University has long acted as an enabler of Israel's crimes and an opponent of Palestinian liberation. We call on all members of the University community – students, staff, and faculty – to continue applying pressure upward until divestment is achieved and Palestinians are free.
