**4:10 p.m.** Principal's Report - Candice Laviaguerre, Principal (presented by Christine Anderson in Candice's absence)

#### Growth & Decline Updates

- CME is not being paired but we are still impacted
- Current 5th graders will be the last 6th grade class
- The suggestion to the board is that they redraw our boundaries (we would get all of Firelight which is an additional 102 students)
- There have been a lot of tours and we've already picked up 7 kindies from Heritage
- Expected growth in the younger grades which is what we need
- Need to work out logistics for current 4th graders - they will talk with middle school to make sure they don't get lost
- CME is open to sending both next year's 5th and 6th graders to Outdoor Ed
- Continuation will be celebrated as well
- All of Highlands Ranch will go to middle in 6th
- Outdoor ed is booked a year in advance so probably already scheduled

#### Class Lists

- Candice sent out the Google form for requests - deadline is April 18th
- Staff will build the lists on the 30th
- They look at parent requests and will be compiling lists with the current classroom teachers as well as learning specialists
- Since there are only two classes per grade they do their best to accommodate peer requests but no guarantees

#### Staff Updates

- Osowski retiring - Dunn moving to Kindie
- Troxel going part-time as librarian - Feinstein moving to 1.0 math intervention
- DeLeon moving from 1st to 2nd grade
- Higgins moving from 6th to 5th grade
- Hiring a 1st grade teacher and 6th grade teacher
- The District is projecting 30 kindies, but we are already at 25, so the expectation is to grow past 30
- We would like to keep Kindie classes capped at 18:1 so we may hire an additional Kindie teacher if needed
- The 6th grade teacher is not a 1 year position - they will be able to go up to the middle school if they want; they will have a job just not in the same building

#### CMAS Update

- Testing starts April 8th
- Introducing incentive programs for attendance and behavior during testing
- Requested that testing dates go out earlier in the year
- It appears that the calendar on the website is not being updated regularly
- Admin is being trained on the website soon

#### 25/26 Curriculum Purchases

- iReady Math and Reading Personalized Learning - \$9,500
- Ready Math Consumables - \$7,700
- StemScopes Science Digital License & Science Materials - \$1,950
- Subs for Planning days - \$7,800
- Various other curriculum (Tme for Kids, Discovery Ed, etc.) - \$4,500
- Paper, cardstock, supplies - \$2,500
- Staff personal development - we received \$12,000 personal donation plus \$6,000 from district
