Introduction

Hair extensions are a common sight these days, so finding a good Weft Sealer can make things less stressful and easy. Let's find out how.

For people with hair extensions, there's no greater horror than shedding hair from the weaves. Luckily, for us, there exists an easy solution—a Weft Sealer. If you haven't used a weft sealer for weaves, then this is the right place for you. With different hair weft sealer reviews, we also have a quick weft sealer 101 in store for you. Find out what a Weft Sealer for weave is, how to use it, and six of the best weft sealer alternatives. All in one place.

What is Weft Sealer?

A weft sealer is an adhesive that is safe to use on your tracks (wefts). It prevents the hair from shedding by providing extra support and hold. To do so, you can also try the [fray check weft sealer](#).

Note: It does not completely stop the shedding, but it does reduce it significantly.

There are multiple options available in the market like the hair extensions 101 weft sealer, extensions plus weft sealer, and many others. You can also get a weft sealer Walmart sells but it may not be as effective as it says. OR you could simply buy a good, tested weave weft sealer from Amazon without leaving your home (and avoiding unnecessary delivery charges). If you have a Prime membership, that's just a bonus.

How to Use a Weft Sealer (Step by Step)

To successfully apply the wefts, follow the steps given below.

Step 1: Spread the Hair on a Dry Towel

You can also use a newspaper instead of a towel if you wish.

Step 2: Comb the Hair Down

Separate any hair attached to the weft for smooth application.

Step 3: Apply Thin Layer of Weft Sealer

Using a brush apply the hair weave weft sealer onto the weft **only**. Let it dry for a few minutes.

Note: This time may vary based on the thickness and composition of the weft sealer that you use.

Step 4: Flip it Over, Repeat

Once dry, turn the hair over and repeat the same process on the opposite side. Don't forget the corners or your hair may not stick on properly.

That's it!

Now all you must do is wait for the product to dry completely to avoid making a mess and apply the weft like a pro.

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Detailed Product Reviews

1. Redken Unisex Extreme Length Sealer Treatment

When you use too many products on your scalp, it elevates hair fall and damage. To deal with this, our first option on this list is the *Redken Unisex Extreme Length Sealer Treatment*. It works tremendously as a split-end treatment and repairs any hair damage. It is a part of a product range designed to achieve maximum hair length.

This product is for those who expose their hair to chemicals like weft sealers. Thus, it is at the top of our list of the best weft sealer reviews. To get the best results, use it as a regular hair serum. Apply it on the mid-lengths through the ends. We recommend getting the whole range of the length sealer treatment products by Redken to maximize the benefits.

The *Redken Unisex Extreme Length Sealer Treatment* is an anti-snap treatment that helps smooth hair cuticles and prevents breakage. At the same time, it fortifies the hair damage caused by chemicals that you use on your hair like hair sealers.

Note: This is not a weft sealer but will come in handy if you want to minimize the damage caused to your hair by the strong weft sealers.

Pros: Prevents hair damage, boosts hair growth

Cons: not a weft sealer

2. Ultra Hold Liquid Bond Glue

The *Ultra Hold Liquid Bond Glue* works well with tape in hair extensions and wigs but can also be used as a weft sealer. The product is not very expensive and lasts a long time (approximately 2 to 3 weeks). Make sure you use it on the tape or weft only as it does not bond well with synthetic or human hair.

The key to using this product is patience. It takes a while to dry so if you don't have a lot of time to apply the hair, this may not be the product you want. Luckily, we have four faster options lined up for you. You can skip directly to the [next one](#) to save time. For those who don't want to miss out on a great product, read on.

If time is not a constraint, we recommend using a paintbrush rather than the brush that comes with it. This will lower the probability of a messy application. When paired with the right remover, the removal process is also smooth. Overall, this is a great product the only problem we faced was its stickiness which made it dry slower than the other hair weft sealers. If you're planning to wear the wig or extensions for a long period, then this should be your go-to hair weft sealer.

Pros: long-lasting results, easy to remove

Cons: takes very long to dry

3. Proclaim Dark Super Bond Hair Glue

If you're looking for a quick, easy, and non-messy way to bond wefted hair this virgin hair weft sealer is right for you. It comes in a squeeze bottle which makes the application a lot faster. And without any brushes involved, it's always less messy.

Simply drag it on the surface of the weft and squeeze, this will minimize mess and help you put it on like a professional. The formula keeps extensions bonded tightly until you want to remove them and can only be removed by a remover like the C-22 solvent adhesive remover. What we love about the *Proclaim Dark Super Bond Hair Glue* is that it can be used for any color wefted hair.

A word of caution would be to avoid applying this product directly to your scalp. We didn't experience any side effects but according to some reviews, it may cause a burning sensation.

Pros: strong bond glue, long-lasting

Cons: causes burning sensation sometimes, not ideal for lighter hair colors

4. Salon Pro 30 Second Bonding Glue

If you've read any Salon Pro weft sealer reviews, you know one thing. They work fast. So, without any doubt the *Salon Pro 30 Second Bonding Glue* does justice to the brand and adheres well to the tracks within 30 seconds. This is the fastest adhesive to lock your weaves in place at a reasonable price.

It dries fast so it is perfect for people (like us) who are always in a rush. Professional hairdressers working as hairstylists for theatres and movies can use this glue to hold the actor's hair into place. It

can also be used to create perfect hairstyles during weddings, graduations, or any other special occasion. In simple words, this is the ultimate weft sealer that hairstylists swear by.

The *Salon Pro 30 Second Bonding Glue* is anti-fungal. It prevents itching or irritation in the scalp. Use it with the Salon Pro 30 sec weft sealer remover for a quick and mess-free application and removal process. The product is manufactured in the USA and suits all hair types and is itch-free.

Note: The formula includes latex rubber.

Pros: Can be used for braiding and weaving, 30-second formula

Cons: visible on lighter hair colors

5. NEW Ultra Hold Acrylic Adhesive with Brush Applicator

The *New Ultra Hold Acrylic Adhesive with Brush Applicator* is the perfect shedding solution. It comes in a convenient travel-sized packing so you can simply carry it wherever you go. If you like wearing multiple wigs or change wefts regularly then this is the best adhesive for you. It works on lace front wigs, toupees, and all hair systems.

The weft sealer amazon sells are all amazing, but this one bond well and dries faster than most adhesives. The Easy Track weft sealer shed stop weft sealer, hair extensions 101 weft sealer or frankly any weft sealer at Walmart is beaten by the strong and quick-dry formula of this product. It is waterproof and shines free which gives the extensions a much natural appearance.

The removal is also quite simple, clean the weft with the C-22 Remover or lace release or use 99% medical alcohol to wipe off the glue. The applicator brush is also easy to use and helps make the application process as little mess as possible. It does seem a bit runny at first, but with time, you'll get used to the liquid formula. It is different than the no-tape adhesives in the market, but its result makes this product worth your time.

Not as fast as the Salon Pro Easy Track Weft Sealer but delivers great results. Let the product dry for five minutes before attaching your hair system to avoid an untidy application.

Pros: A firm hold, travel-friendly, easy to remove

Cons: takes longer to dry off

6. Salon Pro Anti-Fungus Hair Bonding Glue

If you are looking for a weft sealer for virgin hair, your search ends now. This phenomenal weft sealer by Salon Pro bonds to wefted hair and leaves no traces when applied correctly. The *Salon Pro Anti-Fungus Hair Bonding Glue* adheres to synthetic and human hair.

It is meant for professional use only and does a bang on job holding the hair in place for a long time. This product is perfect for those who are tired of low-quality hair glues and want a hassle-free glue for every hair system there is. The only drawback we noticed was its pungent odor. It goes away with time, but it was a big no-no for our expert.

The product contains rubber latex in its composition which may cause an allergic reaction in some individuals. Otherwise, it is worth every buck. To remove it without damaging or breaking your hair follicles, use a hair bonding glue remover (preferably the Salon Pro Hair Bonding Glue Remover).

You can get the *Salon Pro Anti-Fungus Hair Bonding Glue* in two colors—white and black. For light shades of hair like blonde, the white-colored formula covers the tracks well. The same goes for the black alternative which is perfect for darker hair colors. Thanks to the twist cap, you can use this glue

for a long time before it dries off completely. To make things better, this product is anti-fungal which means you won't experience any itchiness or irritation in your scalp.

Pros: Available in two colors, anti-fungal formula

Cons: Smells bad

Buyer's Guide

Do your hair wefts keep coming off? Have you tried every type of hair system there is, but the problem persists?

Well, you've been looking in the wrong places!

The easiest fix in such cases is using a weft sealer. To find out what a weft sealer is, click [here](#). Readily available on Amazon, weft sealers help your weave stay in place without many efforts. Be sure to buy a product that has a good rating and the least side effects.

To help you pick the best weft sealer we have turned every stone and come up with the six best options. Don't trust the products on this list blindly, know why we chose them. If you're not well-versed with the what and if's of weave sealers, here is a crash course on selecting the right weft sealer for weaves.

Selecting a Good Weft Sealer

You know the trick to perfectly holding your hair weaves in place now. But using any hair weft sealer won't be enough. There are many fake products in the market and products that barely hold hair extensions together. So, how can you find out which weft sealer is the one for you?

Focus on the following factors when buying weft sealers and you'll be good to go.

1. What brand is it?

Maybe you're not a brand freak but the thing with weft sealers is, you should stick to the reputed sellers only. Like the 101 weft sealer, Salon Pro weft sealer, and so on. It becomes difficult to choose a good product as there are multiple brands in the market.

So, we recommend playing it safe and going with the popular brands only. If you feel like experimenting, try a different brand or product from the same brand. But make sure you always select a trustworthy label. These products are tried and tested by thousands of other people and you can use them without worrying about the result. Any cheap or low-quality product may cause an infection or increase hair fall.

2. Is it reasonably priced?

Notice that we said reasonably priced and not cheap. If you get a good product at a cheap rate, go ahead. But a low cost does not always get you the best quality. Similarly, buying a ridiculously expensive weft sealant is not practical and does not guarantee a good product.

For example, an \$8 weft sealer may work better than a \$50 hair weave sealant. The cost does not determine quality. So, make sure you buy the weave sealer from a trusted brand to get the best quality. When it comes to hair sealers, you'll be applying it on your scalp (in a way). If the quality is not good, then it can damage your natural hair. Compromising on quality to get a cheaper product is not advised.

3. Was it made for weaves?

Before adding the product to your cart make sure it is meant for weaves and not just wigs. There are sealants manufactured only for weave hair, but some aren't meant to be used as weft sealers. Nevertheless, many products aren't manufactured as weft sealers, but people have used them on their weaves and experienced amazing results.

The best thing about these products people accidentally come across is that they are often, cheaper than weft sealers. But there is always a risk of getting infected when you try this tactic. So, unless necessary, stick to the trusted brands and products made specifically for weaves and save yourself the trouble.

4. How long does it take to dry off?

Another important factor to consider when buying a weft sealer is the time it takes to dry. Some products take 15 to 20 minutes or even hours to dry off completely, not everyone has that much time. But these products stay on longer than the instant drying alternatives, so that's something. If you don't have that much time and want a quick fix for your weaves, then we suggest going with the Salon Pro 30 Second range of products. These hair weft sealants take only 30 seconds to dry off and hold the wig or weft into place a lot longer than products you buy from any beauty store.

Say No to Shedding of the Hair

After applying the weft sealant, follow the steps given below to keep your hair from shedding.

When exposing your hair to so many chemicals, you can't be too careful. Even though you've sealed your hair some tips can help you manage the weave better, they are:

1. Proper Maintenance

When you've new hair on, it's natural to be tempted and try on new hairstyles every so often. But before doing so, think of the outcome. This will only wear your hair off faster than it is supposed to. Why?

It's obvious, the more you style them, the more they are being pulled. This leads to the breakage of hair which spoils it in return.

Maintaining the hair extensions is of utmost importance to avoid shedding. Cover your hair before sleeping to ensure causing minimum damage to them. Another advice is to wear them down as often as possible instead of tying them into a bun or a ponytail. This eliminates the need to straighten or blow dry them all the time.

2. Sewing

If you like to sew your hair weaves, try sewing around the weft tracks. This minimizes shedding as opposed to when you sew them directly into the track. For people with no experience, we recommend getting professional help rather than doing it yourself watching some unreliable video.

Sewing around the weft will allow it to hold on longer. When paired with a weft sealer, the match will be inseparable (until you want it to come off obviously). If you're determined and want to sew in your wefts, follow this detailed [tutorial](#) carefully. The process may take a while, but it is not impossible to accomplish.

3. Take Care of Your Hair Too

Like you care for your real hair, doing the same for hair wefts and extensions is also important. After cleaning, spray the hair with oil to maintain its glossy and silky soft look. Comb it regularly to avoid tangling and use only a wide-toothed comb for it. Using a thin-toothed comb will lead to more breakage and shedding of hair with all the excessive pulling of hair.

We understand the urge to iron them every day to get perfectly straight hair or curl them often. But too much heat can ruin the wig or extensions itself (just like it does to your natural hair). Use a heat protector before using any such equipment on the hair. Even so, minimize exposing it to heat as much as possible.

For all the hair that your weave has already shed, we know it can get very frustrating to clean. But with these [12 ultimate vacuum cleaners for tile floors](#), you can cut the effort and time to half.

How Can You Comb and Clean the Hair?

As we mentioned earlier, comb the hair using a wide-toothed comb instead of the comb that you'd generally use. This reduces breakage and keeps the weave intact for a longer duration. Also, as opposed to your normal combing direction, comb the hair from the tips to the roots. Combing the hair is important as it prevents tangling and thus lowers the possibility of shedding.

To clean a human hair extension, use half a cup of shampoo and lukewarm water. We recommend using dry shampoo as it moisturizes the hair extension maintaining its shine. To wash the hair follow these steps:

- Apply the shampoo and place the extensions in a sink for less than 10 minutes.
- Be sure **not** to swish or swirl them as it will create knots and lead to shedding.
- Rinse the shampoo and drain excess water by squeezing it.
- Deep condition it.
- Let it dry overnight by placing it inside a towel

Remember to deep condition the hair as it helps the hair retain moisture and its texture.

Word of advice-don't use the same weaves for more than three months. They lose shine and don't look like they used to, just replace them after regular intervals. Take proper care of the weaves and hair extensions and use them for months without any problem.

Why Bother?

Shedding and hair fall are common problems faced by individuals. Avoiding it can severely deter the quality of your weave and make it seem dull. Taking proper care can help you save the time, effort, and money that you'd have to spend when replacing the weaves every time they get a little dirty.

Using a weft sealer while installing weaves is also helpful. It ensures that the hair stays in place and does not start shedding or get loose. Follow all the steps given above and you'll notice that your weaves will last longer than they previously did.

FAQ

Q: How long will it last in the hair?

A: Depending on the composition and product, every weft sealant lasts between a few days and a few weeks in the weave. If you apply it correctly, then a strong adhesive weft sealer can last for months too. It must only come off with a proper weft sealer remover.

Q: Is this product compatible with hair extensions or just weaves?

A: The answer is subjective to the product in question. Different adhesives are manufactured with a specific purpose in mind. This product is compatible with weaves, hair extensions, and lace wigs.

Q: How do you remove it?

A: Use a professional quality sealant glue remover or 99% medical alcohol to remove the adhesive from the weave. In some cases, it can also be removed with the help of a generic shampoo and washed off with water.

Q: Is there any side effect I should know of?

A: Most weft sealers use rubber latex in their formula which can cause a reaction to some. But other than that, the side effects that are generally observed are itchiness and irritation in the scalp. But we

have tried and tested the product under expert supervision and have experienced no such side effects.
