General Information

Welcome!

Thank you for joining us for the first (of hopefully many) Little Mulberry Classic! If you have any feedback about the tournament please contact me!

Tournament Central: TC will be in the large pavilion near the course. **Check-in is Mandatory.** Please check in by 8:30.

Bathrooms and Water: Bathrooms are located on the opposite end of the parking lot from hole 1. There will be water at Tourney Central, and a cooler near hole 18 (on the walk from 9 to 10).

PDGA Live Scoring: At least one person from each group needs to fill in the PDGA live scoring. **Every player needs to keep score! PDGA Live is preferred** for all scoring. If you keep score in any way besides PDGA Live you must submit the scorecard to me **after verifying scores with your cardmates!** To login to live scoring, go to PDGA.com/score and enter the passcode (Mulberry).

Layouts: MPO, MP40, MP50, MA1, MA2, MA40, and MA50 will play long Tees. All other divisions will play short Tees.

CTPs: There are 10 Cash CTPs (closest to the pin) in play, 5 for each pool (5 for Longs and 5 for Shorts). CTP payouts will be proportional to how many from each pool paid into the CTP fund.

Long Pool: 1, 5, 7, 14, 17

Short Pool: 3, 6, 11, 13, 18

Please make sure the CTP is for your tee group before moving or marking it! CTPs will be color coded to your tee group (Blue for long tees, Red for short tees) and have the tee group written on them. If you did not buy in to the CTP when you signed up you can buy in at Check-In.

Ace Pot: If someone in the Ace pot hits an ace, they will earn the ace pot and a portion of the Bonus Ace Pot. Multiple aces split the pot equally. Ace and CTP Winners will be paid the next day.

Bonus Ace Pot: \$357. If someone in the Ace Pool hits an Ace, they will earn the Event Ace Pot and a Bonus equal to the length of the hole in feet as long as there's enough in the pot. If you ace a 248 ft hole you'll earn an extra \$248! If multiple people hit aces and there isn't enough to cover all aces, the Bonus Ace Pot will be paid out proportionally based on the length of the holes ached. For example, if there is \$405 in the bonus pot, and there's a 300ft Ace and a 200ft Ace hit, the person who hit the 300ft ace will receive 60% of the pot (\$243), and the one who hit the 200ft ace will receive the remaining 40% (\$162).

Player's Pack: Player's pack is a \$20 voucher to JRDG (on-site and online). The remainder after fees is going into am payouts. I will be set up with a large selection on site available for sale, but **If you want to make sure a specific [disc from the website](#) is available contact Joe.**
