5		Principal's Report	<p>MEAP scores are in...</p> <p>In 3rd-5th grade, there are 8 categories...</p> <p>Bemis ranked 1st in 5 categories, 2nd in two others, and 5th overall statewide. (Approximately 2500 schools)</p> <p>Boulan was 1st in the state for middle schools.</p> <p>It is unknown what Troy High placed this year. Last year's ranking was 1st.</p> <p>There was a county forum for Visible Thinking last month. TSD held a seminar, and Bemis held a parent seminar as well. Additional seminars for parents are in the planning stages.</p> <p>7 other elementary schools are looking at our Visible Thinking Routines program and wanting to implement it in their schools.</p> <p>There is a potential bond issue for TSD next year, which will likely be used for technology improvements.</p> <p>Other needs for Bemis: kindergarten playground equipment for the newly expanded space.</p> <p>Hard wired presentation equipment for the cafe for assemblies and the like.</p> <p>New risers for kids music performances</p> <p>Microphone system for the stage so propel sitting at the back can hear the kids as well.</p> <p>Bemis will be closed to schools of choice for the coming year. We have enrollment now for 92 kindergarten students for fall 2013. There will be 4 kindergarten sections for the fall. The plan is to use the room currently occupied by the MICI class in centrum 1. It is unknown at this time where that class will be moved.</p> <p>Please make sure you send in your intent form when it comes home with your student. It aids in planning and staffing for us to know which children will be returning to Bemis in the fall.</p> <p>Based on the current numbers, and incoming registrations, we will have roughly 550-575 students in the fall.
