

Shortcut in the Search Bar:

Google Advanced Search Page:

Try a **basic “AND”** search on your topic....remember to only use the *most important terms!*

Google teens drugs

all these words: teens drugs

Try **limiting by domain**. You can type *site:.edu, .org, or .gov* after your search terms or use the advanced search page to limit by site or domain.

Google teens drugs site:.edu

site or domain: .edu

Try **limiting by date**. You can click on “Tools” and then “Anytime” and select *past year* or a *custom date range*.

last update: past year

Try an **exact phrase search** on the advanced search page or lock phrases together in *quotes* using the search box.

Google teens "drug abuse"

this exact word or phrase: drug abuse

Try searching for **alternative terms** by going to the advanced search page and typing your terms in the *“Any of these words” box*. You can also simply put the word *OR* in between similar terms.

Google teen OR adolescent OR youth "drug abuse"

any of these words: teen adolescent youth

Try **removing unrelated results** by going to the advanced search page and using the *“None of these words” box*. You can also put a *- sign* touching the words you are trying to get rid of.

Google teen "drug use" -adult

none of these words: adult
