Canvas Panels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5-6 Gessoed canvas on cardboard • 9" x 12" • If you have a preferred painting surface that is different than this, that is fine. 	
Paint brushes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2-flat size 10-12 • 1-filbert size 8-10 • 1-round size 1-2 • Eyedropper (plastic) <p>** Palette knife for mixing paint</p>	
Mark Makers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pencils • 1-Black crayon • Charcoal • Eraser <p>** Copic Sketching Grays #2, #4, #6</p>	
Adhesives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • double sided tape • glue stick 	
Containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2- large (wide) bottom plastic containers (repurpose large cottage cheese or soup take-out) • 1 -Small (wide) bottom plastic containers (repurpose a salsa or hummus container) 	
Paper cutters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scissors • Xacto knife 	
Palette	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 well white plastic palette with lid (dollar stores carry these) 	
Clean-Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2-3 white dish towels/rags • Apron or XXL old t-shirt 	
Collage materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please collect a few magazines with images of people, places, and things. 	
Acrylic Paints	<p>Winsor & Newton, Golden, Blick Artist Acrylics, or any acrylic paint of a similar quality</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Artist</i> grade paints are usually the best. • <i>Student</i> and <i>studio</i> grades are usually inferior, but they are the more budget option. • Buying a set can be a good deal, but you won't get all of the colors that we need, and get some that we don't • If you'd prefer a specific brand of acrylic paint, that is fine. But please match these colors exactly

Yellow - 5.0 Y		SPECTRUM YELLOW or Primary yellow
Blue - 5.0 B		COBALT BLUE or Primary Blue
White		PERMANENT WHITE (this goes fast, so you might need a second one.)

Black	JET OR IVORY BLACK
