Grade 6 Math (All Students)

Student progress in math will be reviewed in the **Spring of their 6th-grade year**. For placement into **Accelerated Math in Grade 7**, we review the following data points as criteria for course placement:

- Trimester Averages
- Homework Completion Rate
- iReady Math District Benchmark Assessments
- Selected Unit Assessment Scores
- Smarter Balanced Assessment Data
 - Summative Assessments
 - Interim Block Assessments
- Classroom Work Habits/Teacher Recommendation

Students accepted into Accelerated Math must meet the majority of designated criteria established. If they meet these criteria, they will be recommended for Accelerated Math in Grade 7. If they do not meet these criteria, they will be recommended for Grade 7 Math.
