Infectious disease

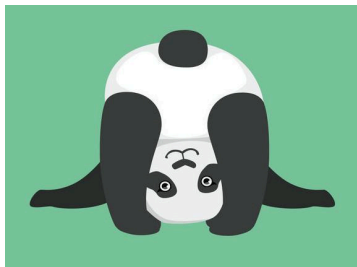
An infectious disease is a disease that can spread from one person to another or from an animal to people. Infectious diseases can make us ill.
