

The final exam is worth 10% of your semester two grade and it covers everything from the list below. It is scantron but you will also need to write a paragraph as well (could be on your likes and dislikes, favorite activities, etc.--you won't know until the day of the exam!).

- **The review packet:** this covers 99.9% of what will be on the exam so it is really the best main source of finals practice for you!
