

These are the workshop options you can request if you come to campus on this Community Learning Day:

1 - ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery): take a multiple-choice test used by the U.S. military to assess a candidate's qualifications for enlistment and to determine their strengths for various military jobs. (Grades 10-12 only)

2 - Come volunteer at the Connect K8 campus and help younger davincians in the classroom and campus.

3 - Come have an awesome time warming up with some volleyball drills then moving into a fun tournament for all skill levels!

4 - A three-hour basketball mini-camp and tournament designed to develop fundamental skills, encourage teamwork, and provide players with competitive game experience.

5 - Soccer Workshop & Tournament: Come get some exercise while enjoying the beautiful game!
