

Political Systems (cont)

- Hundreds of citizen jurors
- Origin of free speech in court
- Factionalism: Who has the final say? Aristocrats, generals, citizens, those on the front lines?
 - Could result in exile, up to 10 years
 - Vote on who to exile
 - If a threshold is reached, the unwanted (most voted for) party would be expelled
 - Primarily tyrants and enemy sympathizers
 - How could this possibly go wrong? See the short blurb about Aristides on pg. 34 (last paragraph of the section)
 - Discussions emerge on proto-constitutions
- Re-emergence of Law codes: 6 types, 3 good, 3 bad
 - Democracy: Exploits Wealthy
 - Oligarchy: Exploits Poor
 - Tyranny: Exploits Everyone
 - Kingship: Rule a single man of impeccable virtue
 - Aristocracy: Rule by a group of the most virtuous
 - Republic: Best parts of Oligarchy and Democracy
- Tyrants sneak their way in, indecision-> frustration-> bad decisions
 - Some stem from coups
 - All Tyrants are dictators, not all dictators are tyrants
 - Lawgivers
