Subject - B.A.A.G. Reorganisation.

Herewith please find my recommendations concerning the rearrangement of the work and re-distribution and changes in personnel considered desirable if the recent proposals concerning B.A.A.G. are approved.

2. It is proposed that the present B.A.A.G. Headquarters (until recently stationed at KWEILIN) be divided into two, B.A.A.G. EAST and B.A.A.G. WEST. The former to be stationed east of the CANTON - KOWLOON and the latter to the west of the railway; the exact location of the former is to be decided after a report is received from Lt. Col. ROOPER who is in command of an advance party which has been sent across to reconnoitre the area; B.A.A.G. WEST is to be stationed temporarily at TUSHAN.

3. B.A.A.G. EAST.

(a) Duties.

All M.I.9, Intelligence and Counter Espionage activities in the HONGKONG - CANTON area will be directed from B.A.A.G. EAST through the existing forward area posts at WAICHOW and YANPING.

Any new M.I.9 operations e.g. Indians in SWATOW, preparations for evasion and rescue operations in connection with a possible landing on the China coast, will be controlled from B.A.A.G. EAST.

(b) Establishment.

This post will be under the Command of the COMMANDANT and the personnel will be composed of members of M.I.9 Intelligence and Counter Espionage Sections, together with W/T operators, cipher, administrative, Medical and M/T personnel. In addition it is anticipated that Force 136 personnel will also be attached to B.A.A.G. EAST. The details of the recommended establishment are set out in Appendix I.

(c) Communications.

B.A.A.G. EAST will be in W/T communication with WAICHOW, YANPING and any agents we may be able to equip with W/T in enemy occupied areas, as well as B.A.A.G. WEST and CHUNGKING.

Runner communication will be set up with A.H.Q. at WAIGHOW and communication with B.A.A.G. WEST by bag will be maintained by air as long as this remains possible.

(d) Transport.

Two (2) jeeps and trailers will be required to make the post completely mobile in addition to the 3 ton lorry already over the other side in KUKONG.

(e) Administration & General.

Accounts will be kept according to a field accounting system and forwarded to Accounts Section B.A.A.G. WEST as regularly as possible.

This branch of the Headquarters is to be kept as mobile as possible hence files and records are to be reduced to a minimum; this will mean that most of the communication to higher formations will be by cipher signal, demanding an increase in cipher staff for which B.O.R.'s are recommended.

The clerical staff will be established as a typist pool rather than having clerks assigned to the various sections, by which means it is expected that this work will require only two B.O.R. typists.

(f) Local Protection.

In view of the fact that it is uncertain how much VIIIth War Zone troops can be depended upon in the event of the Japanese cutting the area off completely from CHUNGKING, it is recommended that one platoon of the CHINA UNIT if available be posted for duty with B.A.A.G. EAST.

4. B.A.A.G. WEST.

(a) Establishment.

This post will be commanded by B.A.A.G. 2/c and the detailed establishment will be found set out in Appendix II.

(b) Duties.

All B.A.A.G. administration and accounts will be controlled by the WEST section which will also house the stores, records and archives.

All Intelligence reports from forward areas will be forwarded to 'I' Section B.A.A.G. WEST who will be responsible for the preparation and printing of K.W.I.Z. B.A.A.G. WEST will provide one Liaison officer to be posted at 4th War Zone Headquarters (now at LIUCHOW), and one member of the Chinese Staff at NANNING; the purpose of this latter post is to receive and despatch bags from YANPING and to supervise the runner service through the enemy lines.

M.I.9 operations in HAINAN Island will be carried out from the WEST Headquarters and all B.A.A.G. M.I.9 reports will be compiled there and distributed to higher formations. Counter espionage intelligence will be collated and all files kept at Headquarters WEST and the C.E. précis published there. B.A.A.G. WEST is thus responsible for all the collating filing and distribution of K.W.I.Z. and M.I.9 and C.E. reports.

(c) Communications.

B.A.A.G. WEST will maintain W/T communication with B.A.A.G. EAST and with CHUNGKING.

Bags will be received and despatched from for B.A.A.G. EAST as air transport permits and for YANPING via NANNING post.

5. CHANGES IN ESTABLISHMENT.

Appendix III sets out the present establishment, recommended establishment and changes. The case for the changes recommended is as follows:-

(a) It is highly desirable that the excellent relations and liaison recently set up between our Headquarters and the IVth War Zone should be maintained. This is the only means whereby we shall be able to obtain accurate information concerning the operations in the LIUCHOW area. It is recommended that a MAJOR I.O. be appointed as liaison officer to carry out these duties.

(b) Under the present establishment we have only been able to maintain our efficiency by borrowing officers from Force 136. At the present moment the following Force 136 officers are attached to us doing wholly B.A.A.G. duties:-

It is recommended that our establishment be enlarged to take over these officers, so that in the event of Force 136 wishing to expand their activities, the work of the B.A.A.G. will not be affected by the withdrawal of the officers mentioned.

(c) As there will be a great amount of cipher signal traffic it is considered that both B.A.A.G. EAST and WEST will require 1 officer and 2 B.O.R's each on their cipher staff being an increase of 1 officer and 4 B.O.R's.

(d) The following B.O.R's are required for the transport section:-

1 N.C.O. and 4 Driver Mechanics; these have already been the subject of a previous communication, see A/3/101, dated 5th October 1944.

(e) Chinese Liaison officers.

In the forward areas we have found it absolutely essential to utilise the services of Chinese in our dealings with the various military departments. In WAICHOW, Mr. PAUL TSUI has performed these duties for over 2 years so ably that to a great extent our being able to hang on there has been due to his tact and excellent work. He is doing the work of an officer and under the new scheme it is more than ever desirable that his position should be regularised.

It is recommended that the new establishment should provide for two such Chinese liaison officers, one at WAICHOW and one at B.A.A.G. EAST, both Captains, but one with the local rank of Major.

(f) Counter Espionage.

With the re-occupation of HONGKONG in view, the work of the C.E. Section becomes of increasing importance. At the present moment the staff (exclusive of clerks) consists of two officers (one British and one Indian) and two Hongkong Chinese (one a solicitor and the other a business man); these latter will be required to move with B.A.A.G. EAST and it is considered desirable that all the staff of this formation should be military personnel. One more British officer will be required for this section with B.A.A.G. WEST and hence it is recommended that to provide for the increase in C.E. work three Captains and/or Lieutenants be added to the establishment, two of which will be recruited locally and be provided by the new establishment, the third will be provided on the old establishment by the vacancy caused by the promotion of one of the existing Captains I.O. to the new Major I.O. (Liaison officer) appointment recommended in 5 (b) above.

(g) Summary.

The above recommendations call for the following additions to the present W.E. (To fill these new appointments only two new officers will need to be appointed from W.E. - see comments Appendix II)

- 1 Major I.O. - 3 one to be liaison officer with IVth War Zone and the other two to absorb the two Majors from Force 136.
- 2 Captain I.O. (Chinese) - 2 These are the new liaison officers
- 1 Capt. or Lieut. (Cipher) - 1
- 0 Capt. or Lieut. (I.O.) - 5 Two of these are for the counter espionage section and the other three to take over the Force 136 personnel at present performing B.A.A.G. duties.

It is recommended that the establishment be worded Captain or Lieutenant, so that the appointment may be filled in the first instance with Lieutenants who may then be promoted after a reasonable length of service if they are considered suitable, without a change in W.E. *Not applicable*

6. FINANCE.

As the cost of living, rents etc. vary so much in China even from town to town it is impossible to predict with any accuracy the additional cost which the setting up of B.A.A.G EAST will involve.

It is therefore suggested that for the months of November and December and January an additional sum of £5,000 per month be allocated to the allotment, at the end of which time it is hoped we shall be able to make definite recommendations
