The Armed Services Vocational Battery (ASVAB) is an aptitude test that covers eight areas related to career exploration. These areas include General Science, Arithmetic Reasoning, Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension, Mathematics Knowledge, Electronic Information, Auto and Shop Information, and Mechanical Comprehension.

Students will receive their Post-Test Interpretation: 45-minute guided career exploration in 2 weeks.

There are no obligations to enter the military after taking this test. If you have any questions please contact Mrs. Bawuah in the Guidance Office.
