# **EARLY CHILDHOOD**

### RELATIONSHIPS

#### HARPER - WWWW

Though their relationship started off rocky due to Bunny's hatred and fear of both men and doctors, present-day Bunny is *deeply* attached to Harper, perhaps moreso than his partner. From the moment he laid eyes on the doctor after his "rebirth", Bunny became dependent on the doctor like a newborn chick to its mother.

Ever since that day, Bunny has been entirely obedient and careless when it comes to Harper. He will follow any instruction or direction given to him by the doctor, without question and without complaint.

Harper finds Bunny to be his greatest achievement. Turning a rabid dog into a docile little rabbit is perhaps the most impeccable transformation he has managed in his entire career. Though, of course, even rabbits have their *moments*. When Bunny has a hiccup in his agreeable nature, Harper has since communicated to anyone around him that he is to be taken *directly* to Harper. After this point, Bunny is admitted into the asylum, and after a week or two of intensive care, he is free to go back to his normal life.
