Bookings Generally

- The booker (i.e., the person who makes a booking) will be held responsible for that booking.
- As a general rule, the booker should attend the booking.

Bookings for Children

- Bookings for children (under 18's) should be made by adults (18 and over).
- Children (under 14) must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Juniors (14 17) are permitted to play at RSC unsupervised, but a parent or carer must have given their consent having made a judgement that it is safe and appropriate for their child/children to use the venue.
- In particular, parents/carers must ensure that their children are able to:-
 - Respond to emergencies.
 - Have sufficient maturity to attend the venue unaccompanied.
 - Use equipment safely and lock up securely after use.
 - Understand and follow the Code of Conduct for Children shown below.

Code of Conduct for Children

ALL CHILDREN MUST AGREE TO:

- Be friendly and supportive. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, culture, religion, sexual identity.
- Play fairly and honestly.
- Take care of club property and lock up correctly after use.
- Not use bad, inappropriate language.
- Not bully, intimidate, or harass anyone.
- Not smoke, drink alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises.
- Do not take food or drink onto the court, including chewing gum.
- Talk to Welfare Officer (Jan Downing) if you have any concerns or worries.
