[Fernanda Hopenhaym](#) - member of the [Working Group on Business and Human Rights](#), which is a special procedure of the Human Rights Council - will provide a rare, first-hand look into UN diplomacy. She will demystify the Human Rights mechanisms that shape global policy and governance. Explore the 80-year legacy of the United Nations and its continuous global impact. M1 - DP2: Masterclass by [Prof Nikhil Soi](#) from [Hult](#) - Thursday 4 December, 12:45-13:30, webinar

For those who were unable to join the vibrant Masterclass by [Prof Nikhil Soi](#) this session unpacked the integration of AI in entrepreneurship. Ideas shared featured businesses currently looking into how to embed AI in their operations; the 5 top factors in success across more than 200 companies; the 2 foreseeable futures: one predicted by Elon Musk the post-work society and the other one by Tristan Harris the uncontrollable God; integrating AI agents generalist in the operations and the fact that you don't need to be a coder but a creative problem solver; the great filter: why most of the AI ventures fail: The traditional "Build-Measure-Learn" feedback loop is being accelerated by AI, which injects automation, predictive analytics, and data-driven insights into every phase; about the fact that AI is the ultimate co-founder and that it handles grunt work, spots patterns humans miss, and scales with your ambitions; the The Modern AI Stack for Founders, the The Art of the Ask: A Formula for Better Prompts: role + objective + context + data = superior output. MYP4 - DP2: [EHL Swiss Hospitality Business School](#) Presentation - Wednesday, 26 November, 13:30-14:15 stand @ DP Cafeteria & 14:15-14:55 DP 1 Core Class Session on CV/Interview Prep

Widely recognized as one of the world's premier institutions for hospitality management and business, EHL is blending a rich heritage of Swiss hospitality expertise with a rigorous modern business management curriculum. Distinct features of this university include its three international campuses (Lausanne, Passugg, and Singapore), intensive hands-on training that features a



Michelin-starred restaurant, and a highly successful career placement rate for its diverse, global student body. Key highlights and messages of the session were for students to **own their application** (know in depth the application documents they submit ranging from the personal statement to the CV which would be the basis of discussion for the interview), **prepare ahead of the interview both the content** (eg: typical questions & questions to the institution) **and the professional attire** but also **demonstrate their interest in the institution** they apply to (eg: website search, key features of the institution, key stats, faculty, etc.). Our guidance counselors pointed out the importance of being strategic in picking up those CAS experiences that enhance the student profile during the application process.

DP2: Dedicated [H-College Career Day](#) session on Career Paths for Business & Economics Students - Friday, 14 November 11:30 am- 12:30 noon, H-Farm Library

Courtesy of **H-College Career Day**, DP2 students enjoyed a tailored session about possible career paths in the Business & Economics sector. Three local partner organizations ranging from consultancy to steel production to food retail shared their valuable insights with our students: KPMG, Bauli and Danieli. Students were eager to learn about various company roles, how to move up in organizations, what companies are looking for, and how these industries will evolve by the time they are graduating from college. They felt that the event helped them glimpse a “day in the life” in these career pathways and organizations, and helped clarify what they might look for in a potential employer in the future.

- **KPMG:** Described how their consultants work with different sectors of industry, including insights about shifting trends in delivery of consulting services after Covid, how to advance in one’s position in the company, and the importance of corporate standards and partnerships.
- **Danieli:** As producers of steel plants around the world, the company focuses on “green steel”, an environmentally friendly, sustainable model for the future of steel production. The speakers explained their supply chain process and discussed the company’s struggle to adapt to the digital market in a world that will always need non-digital steel. They highlighted the need for employees who will transform and grow, rather than people to fill specific roles. Flexibility, adaptability, and eagerness to engage with change are key in this fluid market, where AI and data science have taken center stage.
- **Bauli:** Representatives from IT and HR teams spoke with students through their respective lenses about the company’s undertaking of innovation to their business and consumer processes using generative AI and machine learning. In speaking of career trajectories, they highlighted the importance of exposure to multicultural peers at university, seeking marketing internships, and an ever-changing focus on branding.

During the Visual Art Classes, students benefited from a dedicated presentation and workshop led by [Will Thorburn](#), International Recruitment Coordinator for the University of the Arts London (UAL).



As an artist, painter, and academic—and an alumnus of Central Saint Martins (MA Fine Art, 2016)—Mr. Thorburn offered a valuable insider perspective on pursuing art and design at a top-tier UK institution. He demonstrated examples of successful portfolios and described the process for their submission, including technical aspects such as the type of work that should be included or avoided, recommended number of slides and pieces, and the appropriate amount of accompanying text per page, noting its difference from the more detailed, "wordy" IB portfolio requirements. Mr. Thorburn also described the application pathways for UAL via direct application to a BA program and pre-degree (Foundation Year) courses, and addressed student questions about cost and scholarships for international students.

The first Mini University Fair of the academic year was a resounding success, providing students with an exploration of global education pathways at eight distinct institutions, each known for a specialized approach to learning. Students demonstrated a high level of curiosity and engagement, utilizing the opportunity to pose focused and relevant questions on essential topics. Their inquiries spanned the full journey of higher education, frequently addressing:

- **Entry requirements and admissions:** Students sought clarity on application processes and the specifics of coursework, from the interdisciplinary curriculum at [Bard College Berlin](#) to the Scottish four-year degree structure at the [University of St Andrews](#).
- **Diverse academic programs and experiential learning:** Great interest was shown in unique majors, such as [Gastronomic Sciences](#) ([Università di Scienze Gastronomiche di Pollenzo](#)), the "real work on real projects for real clients" approach at [Raffles Milano](#), and the experiential [hospitality](#), [culinary](#), and spa services laboratories and student-run businesses of the [American University of Florence \(AUF\)](#).
- **Career pathways and industry focus:** Student questions highlighted a desire to understand career outcomes, particularly from institutions renowned for professional links and practical degrees, such as the career-focused education at the [University of Hertfordshire](#) and the applied business focus of the [Geneva Business School](#).
- **Unique learning opportunities and student support:** The personalized teaching and tutor system at [UCAM Spain](#) and the traditional collegiate environment of the [University of St. Andrews](#) were points of enthusiastic discussion, underscoring student interest in support structures and campus culture.

The 2nd Mini University Fair was an equally successful event that provided students with a valuable opportunity to meet directly with representatives from another group of eight international higher education institutions. They engaged enthusiastically with the Admissions representatives and asked insightful questions across a wide spectrum of topics, including:

- **Diverse academic programs and campuses:** Students explored options like the Liberal Arts core at the [American University of Rome \(AUR\)](#), the Experiential Learning model at [John Cabot University](#), the applied learning focus of [Swiss Business School \(SBS\)](#), and the strategic programs at the political hub of the [Brussels School of Governance](#).
- **Curriculum and coursework:** Specific program inquiries focused on popular fields like Business Administration (offered by multiple institutions), [Communication & Digital Media](#) (AUR), International Affairs and Law ([Brussels School of Governance](#), [John Cabot University](#)), [Medicine MBBS](#) St Mary's University), and specialized degrees like [AI & Data Science](#) (H-College).
- **Entry requirements:** Practical questions were asked regarding the admissions process for international and U.S.-accredited degrees.
- **International opportunities:** Interest was shown in unique features such as internships ([European School of Economics](#)), integrated placement years ([St Mary's University](#)), and the global focus of institutions like Grenoble École de Management's [International Bachelor of Business Administration](#).
- **Career pathways beyond graduation:** Students explored how the practical and specialized focuses of these institutions—from technology and innovation to business creation—translate into professional careers.

Hosted by the H-FARM Boarding Team, in collaboration with the University Guidance Department, this special event aimed to provide a unique opportunity for our high school students to look into



personal stories about dreams, hard work, and perseverance from diverse challenges of high school students from across the globe. The chosen documentary, presented by WGPU Public Media, was a powerful artwork depicting the lives of six ambitious high school students, devoted to earning a seat at the US's top colleges of their choice. This poses a compelling question: "Will this hard work ever be enough? This inspiring film sheds light on a demanding life stage, particularly when preparing for university admissions. MYP5 - DP2: Career Guidance & Prospects Q&A Bespoke Session with NYUAD Prof [Marta Losada](#) - Tuesday, 21 Oct, 15:15 - 16:00 @DP Hall

A session geared towards TLF students, DP1 & DP2 Physics students, this Q&A session covered different topics, below naming a few:

- **Career Trajectories:** Professor Losada explored the crucial soft skills required for success in a research field and provided a clear analysis of the differences between a research career path and one in the private sector. Students heard inspiring success stories, specifically highlighting NYUAD Physics undergraduates who advanced to doctoral degrees at Cornell and George Washington Universities.
- **Future of Innovation:** A major focus was placed on quantum computing and its intersection with AI, detailing how this technological convergence is poised to exponentially enhance research across various fields, including medicine.
- **NYUAD Academic Landscape:** The speaker provided an overview of the six undergraduate science fields (Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Engineering, Mathematics, Physics and Psychology) and explained the common science curriculum's essential role in promoting the future of interdisciplinary studies.
- **Research Ecosystem:** Students learned about NYUAD's substantial infrastructure, including the 20 [Research Institute Centers](#), with an emphasis on the 15 centers that are STEM-focused. These centers include high-profile hubs such as the [Center for Interacting Urban Networks \(CITIES\)](#), [Center for Genomics and Systems Biology](#), [Center for Quantum and Topological Systems](#), and the [Water Research Center](#).
- **Global Physics & Experiments:** Professor Losada detailed innovative physics projects around the world, emphasizing the major collaborations she is involved in, including the ATLAS, DUNE, and NEXT Experiments. She also highlighted projects using telescopes in South America and Africa to explore High Energy Physics and its connection with astronomy and particle physics. The discussion included the work being done at CERN (specifically the Large Hadron Collider (LHC) and its main experiments like ATLAS and CMS).
