Counseling support for EDUHSD students!

Sierra Child and Family Services operate a Wellness Center on every campus in the El Dorado Union High School District. The Wellness Center offers short term individual and group counseling as well as connection to community resources.

We are staffed 5 days a week (8 AM - 4 PM) by Mental Health Clinicians and Advocates. The Wellness Centers are open 12 months a year and are able to provide counseling services to students through the summer.

HEALTH OFFICE FORMS

Over the next few months, your student may have a doctor's appointment or physical. At that time, please have the appropriate forms completed and fax, scan or deliver to the main office at Pacific Crest Academy.

If your student takes medication at school on a daily basis or on an as needed basis (this includes any over the counter medication including ibuprofen, Tylenol, cough drops or any allergy medication such as Benadryl), please have your doctor complete

the Medication in School form and sign as the parent/guardian. You will need to supply the medication in the original labeled container to the health office.

If your student has diabetes, please have your doctor fill out the Diabetes Medical Management Plan (DMMP) and sign as the parent/guardian. If any medication/supplies are needed, please provide them at the start of school. Also provide emergency glucagon.

Please use the Aeries Parent Portal to input any and all medical issues. Such as the above information, medication taken at home and any updates. This information is kept confidential but helps in an emergency.

Emergency medications include glucagon, Epi-Pen and albuterol inhaler. Your student can carry these medications. However, you must still provide the above completed forms.
