-Summer Lunch is here! If you'd like to help out with cooking/serving/clean-up/bake cookies, sign-ups are in the fellowship hall!

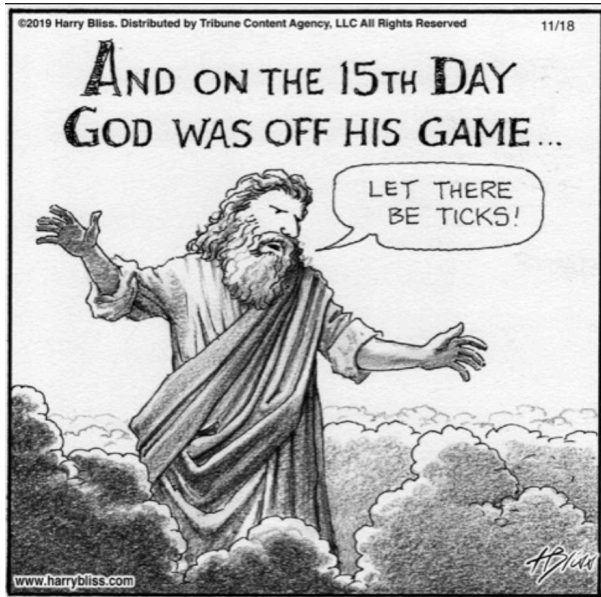
