

Robinson Little League Bylaws

*The **ROBINSON LITTLE LEAGUE** adheres to the rules set forth by Little League International. Local league options for each division are as follows:

PEEWEE BASEBALL (League Age 8 & 9)

- 1. A complete game consists of six (6) innings or one (1) hour and thirty (30) minutes, whichever comes first. No inning may start after the time limit has been reached or after 10:00 p.m. A game is considered an official game after four (4) innings, three and one-half (3 ½) (if the HOME team is ahead) are played. Weather-delayed games or non-official games will be rescheduled/resumed at the discretion of the Board.
- **2.** A continuous batting order and the five-run rule per half inning will be in effect. There is the potential to score up to 8 runs per half-inning.
- **3.** An automatic out will be recorded if a bat is thrown by a player. **No exceptions**.
- **4.** The Ten-Run Rule is in effect. If after four (4) complete innings, three and one-half (3 $\frac{1}{2}$) innings (if the **HOME** team is ahead), one team has a lead of ten (10) runs or more, the manager of the team with the least number of runs shall concede the victory to the team in the lead.
- **5.** Little League Pitch count baseball rules **must** be followed and **must** be recorded in GameChanger.
- **6.** A batter *cannot* square to bunt, pull back, and then either hit or bunt the ball. If the batter does this, he will be called out, and no runners may advance.
- **7.** Catchers must wear the necessary equipment. The catcher must have a "dangling throat protector" attached to the mask. A catcher's mitt is required. A cup is a must for the catcher and is highly recommended for all players.
- **8.** The "Dropped Third Strike" rule is <u>NOT</u> in effect.
- **9.** The Infield Fly Rule *is* in effect.
