



Year 6 Parent Information Booklet 2022-23

Reminders

- School begins at 8.55 am please ensure your child is punctual. Children can come into school any time from 8.45am.
- Absence must be reported to the office first day.
- Holidays during term time are not encouraged as it is detrimental to your child's education. Any holiday request must be agreed with school - see office for form.
- School Uniform consists of red sweatshirt/cardigan, white polo shirt, grey trousers/skirt, black shoes (not trainers)
- PE Kit consists of white t-shirt and black shorts and trainers or plimsols
- It is helpful if uniform and PE Kit have names in to help identify any "lost" property
- Y6 PE Day: Thursday. Children should come to school dressed in their kit on this day.
- Swimming is on Friday. Children need their swimming kit, including a swimming, on this day.

How to support your child in Y6

- Encourage your child to read daily.
- Discuss books, news, and ask questions about what your child reads, especially answers which rely on inference (*'reading between the lines.'*)
- By end of Y6 they should know all multiplication tables to 12 x 12, work out mental calculations quickly, use efficient written methods to calculate the four rules of number, find equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages, have a sound understanding of shape and measure, in particular converting units of measure and time.
- By the end of Y6 children should be able to write in extended sentences and use correctly the following punctuation:
. , ? ! " ' ; : () - ...

- Have a quiet place where your child can do homework without distractions

Concerns

- If your child has problems with homework contact the teacher who will explain it to them.
- If problems occur at home which could affect your child, please let school know. This helps us understand changes in attitude/behaviour
- If you notice any changes in your child's attitude, behaviour which you believe may be caused by bullying let school know as soon as possible.

Homework

- Homework is given on each week on a Friday and should be completed by the following Wednesday.
- Currently, homework will consist of English and mathematics tasks, alternating one week written and one week online. The online work will be set via Mymaths.com and Spag.com. Your child should have individual logins for these sites.
- Encourage children to continue to use TT Rockstars and Spelling Shed regularly.
- Encourage your child to complete homework as soon as they can once it is set.
