



In an effort to do our best to keep our attendees safe, please read in detail our event COVID-19 Guidelines below, as well as our [COVID-19 Waiver of Liability linked here](#), which all guests will be required to sign on site. COVID-19 Guidelines

If you test POSITIVE for COVID and have not tested Negative, please DO NOT COME TO THE EVENT. Further, if you are feeling symptoms that you think might be COVID, please DO NOT COME TO THE EVENT. Emerge California also asks attendees who are feeling ill in any way, or think they have been exposed to any illness, to stay home and take care of themselves.

If you HAD COVID 10+ days prior to the event, but are NO LONGER experiencing symptoms, please ensure you test NEGATIVE via a lab administered PCR test or self-administered rapid test at least one full day prior to the event. Of note, should you have tested positive within the last 10+ days, even if you test negative prior, we do ask that you wear a high-quality mask at the event for the safety of yourself and those present, such as an N95 or 2 surgical masks.

Though we will comply with all state and local ordinances, which currently do not require masks during indoor events, we are requiring our guests to wear masks (guests may remove masks to eat, drink, and take photos.)

Emerge California asks all attendees to consider using COVID safety measures including masking when traveling to the event and in the days leading up to the event, in an effort to reduce exposure to COVID for the safety of yourself and your peers - thank you!

Emerge California asks those who are traveling from outside the area to consider bringing with them self-administered rapid tests, and testing yourself at the first indication of symptoms, as protecting yourself and your peers from illness is of utmost importance.

Though these measures cannot ensure that anyone is protected from COVID, we ask that we all work together in the spirit of public health and community.
