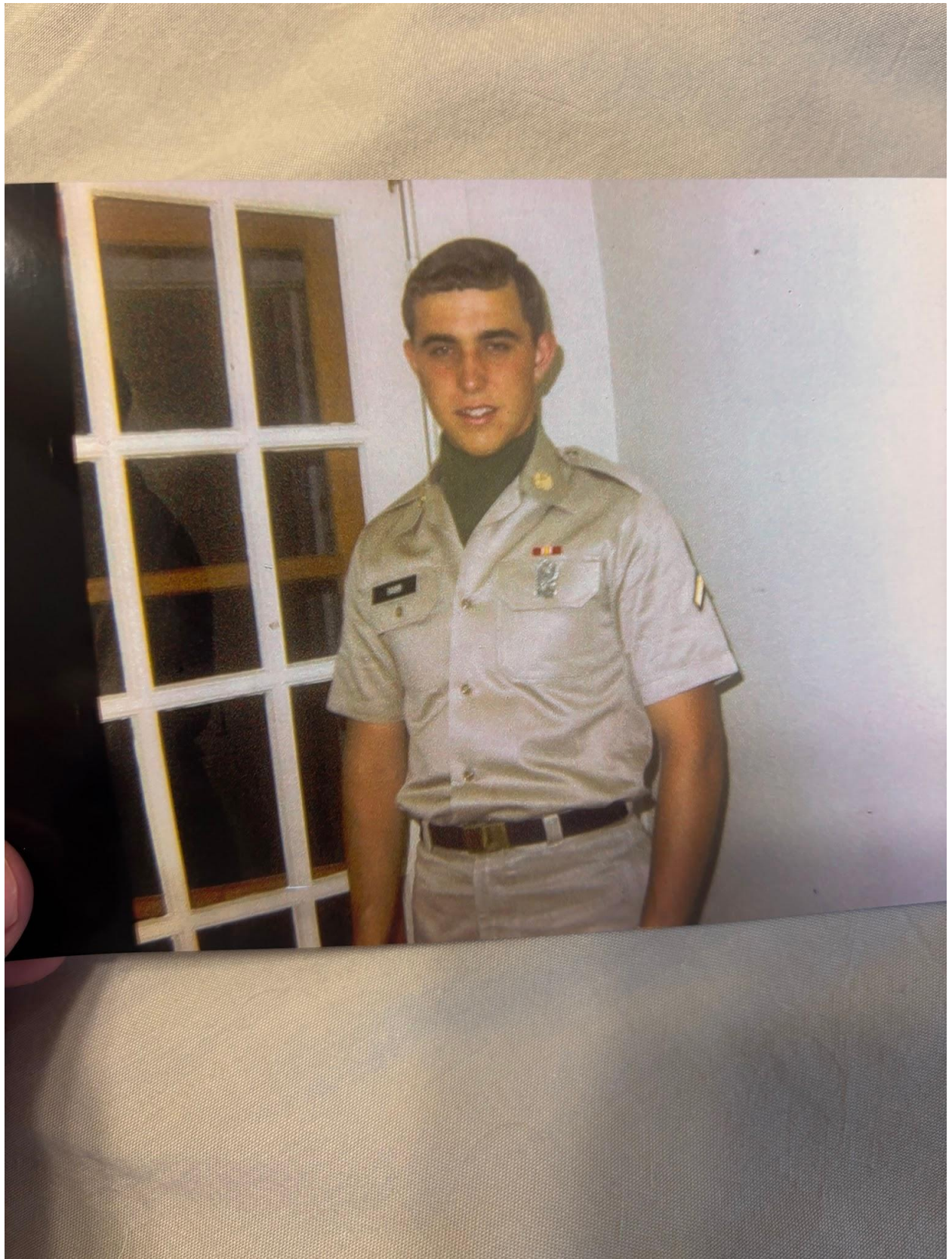


SP4 Phillip Hugh Babb IV (Vietnam)

Phillip Hugh Babb was born in Greene County, TN, to Mr. and Mrs. Robert H. Babb. SP4 Babb was drafted into Vietnam, from East Tennessee out of Greene County. He attended Basic Training at Ft. Campbell KY, and later Military Police School. He was then assigned to the military police company attached to the 9th Infantry Division, stationed roughly 40 miles south east of Saigon. He was assigned to VIP escort, and regularly guarded the division headquarters, the commanding general, and once General Westmoreland (The commander of all US Forces in Vietnam). He regularly participated in convoy escorts, usually at the very front or rear of the formation while in transit between bases. He returned home to Greene County from Vietnam around 1970, becoming employed with the United States Postal Service and eventually retiring in the early 2010s. He continued his education by obtaining a bachelor's degree from East Tennessee State University by utilizing the GI Bill. He still currently resides in Greene County, Tennessee.
