Frequently Asked Questions

Q: I registered online ... now what?

A: If your student's first choices are accepted we will schedule them accordingly. If their first, second, and third choice is not available, we will email you to let you know about the current availability. Rosters will be posted on our web page. If you registered with payment and you DO NOT see your child's name on the online roster, email (DBostrom@sacredheartacademyhempstead.org).

Q: Where do I go the first day of class?

A: The first day of driving classes you will meet in Sacred Heart's general office (entrance is in the back of the building). There your instructors will meet you.

All lecture students will meet in room 107 where your lecture instructor will take attendance.

Q: What are the expectations of Driver Education?

A: Our Syllabus provides you with all the information about our student's expectations. Please remember, this is a high school course and our expectations follow the New York State Education Department and Department of Motor Vehicles. We fulfill NYS *minimum* requirements for driver education.

Q: Are the Classrooms and Cars air conditioned?

A: YES!

Note to Parents/Guardians: Driver Education students should be driving at home regularly before, during, and after driver education. Driving is a skill and it is a team effort to prepare students to drive, please take your part seriously.
