In other words weave little moments of instruction into your play or mini discussions with your child. Examples • As you are shopping, point out the various numerals on price tags and note to your child "Oh look at these numerals. They are telling me how much this costs. Let's see there is a 3, a 5, and a 0 (as you point to the numerals). I will need \$3.50 to buy this. You can also then compare the price tag to the signs that tell what the product is and note whether there are letters or numbers.	It is important for students to understand why we have numbers and letters. The children are learning that we use letters to read and write words and names, while numbers are used to count and answer questions such as how many or how much. Students should also begin to identify whether the symbol is a letter or a numeral by looking at them on a printed page or sign.
